

MINUTE ITEM

10. APPLICATION FOR A RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT OVER TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA FOR A MUNICIPAL PIER, CITY OF OCEANSIDE, SAN DIEGO COUNTY - W.O. 4237, P.R.C. 2848.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 15 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE A 49-YEAR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT, FOR A MUNICIPAL PIER, OVER TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN SAN DIEGO COUNTY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

AN AREA ONE HUNDRED (100) FEET IN WIDTH AND FIFTEEN HUNDRED FIFTY (1550) FEET LONG, LYING ALONG AND BEING FIFTY (50) FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF THE PROLONGATION SEAWARD FROM THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA ON THE CENTERLINE OF THIRD STREET, CITY OF OCEANSIDE, CONTAINING 3.56 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION IS THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR A RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT OVER TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA FOR A MUNICIPAL PIER, CITY OF OCEANSIDE, SAN DIEGO COUNTY - W.O. 4237.

The City of Oceanside has applied for a right-of-way easement over tide and submerged land for a municipal pier; this easement is a replacement for P.R.C. 277.9, which expired January 8, 1962. The pier is located seaward of the end of Third Street, City of Oceanside (see Exhibit "A"). This structure is owned and operated by the City of Oceanside on a nonprofit basis for the use and benefit of the public.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE A 49-YEAR RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT, FOR A MUNICIPAL PIER, OVER TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN SAN DIEGO COUNTY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
