

MINUTE ITEM

18. APPLICATION FOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT; SAN LUIS OBISPO, SANTA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE, AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; MOBIL OIL COMPANY - W.O. 4303, P.R.C. 2871.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 2 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO MOBIL OIL COMPANY A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, IN CONFORMANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION, FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 1, 1962, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 1962, AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA:

- A. LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE SOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF X = 1,441,189.36 FEET AND Y = 335,615.67 FEET.
- B. LYING BETWEEN THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE SOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF X = 1,515,471.78 FEET AND Y = 338,567.70 FEET, AND A LINE FORMING THE NORTH-WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF.
- C. LYING BETWEEN THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL A ABOVE AND THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B ABOVE, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL.
- D. LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.
- E. LYING BETWEEN THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B ABOVE AND THE NORTHWESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL D ABOVE, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA.

APPLICATION FOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT; SAN LUIS OBISPO, SANTA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE, AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; MOBIL OIL COMPANY - W.O. 4303.

An application has been received from Mobil Oil Company for a geological survey permit covering portions of the tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission in San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, Ventura, Los Angeles, Orange, and San Diego Counties, for the six-month period commencing April 1, 1962.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO MOBIL OIL COMPANY A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, IN CONFORMANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION, FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 1, 1962, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 1962, AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA:

- A. LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE SOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF $X = 1,441,189.36$ FEET AND $Y = 335,615.67$ FEET.
- B. LYING BETWEEN THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE SOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF $X = 1,515,471.78$ FEET AND $Y = 338,667.70$ FEET, AND A LINE FORMING THE NORTH-WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF.
- C. LYING BETWEEN THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL A ABOVE AND THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B ABOVE, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL.
- D. LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.
- E. LYING BETWEEN THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B ABOVE AND THE NORTHWESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL D ABOVE, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA.
