

MINUTE ITEM

38. OVER-ALL PLAN FOR DEVELOPMENT IN THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA - W.O. 4352.

In response to a question by the Chairman as to the existence of an over-all plan for development in the San Francisco Bay area, the Executive Officer reported that at present there is no such plan as much of the tide and submerged land area in the Bay is no longer under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission, having either been sold into private ownership, or granted to various municipalities. However, there are a multiplicity of plans representing the desires and programs of the various city and county planning commissions, and several regional councils which are considering Bay area problems.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS DIRECTED TO HAVE THE STAFF (1) DETERMINE WHETHER IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION TO ASSUME LEADERSHIP IN ESTABLISHING A COORDINATED PLAN FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA; (2) ALTERNATIVELY, TO DETERMINE WHAT PUBLIC AGENCY OR AGENCIES SHOULD DESIRABLY ASSUME SUCH RESPONSIBILITY; AND (3) TO REPORT AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO THE FOREGOING AT A SUBSEQUENT MEETING.
