

MINUTE ITEM

6. APPLICATION FOR EXPENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE UNDERWATER EXPLOSION TESTS ON SUBMERGED LANDS OF MONO LAKE, MONO COUNTY; UNITED STATES OF AMERICA - W.O. 4318, P.R.C. 2880.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 8 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE A TEN-MONTH RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMIT, EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 1964, AUTHORIZING THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA TO CONDUCT UNDERWATER EXPLOSION TESTS IN MONO LAKE, MONO COUNTY, IN THE INTEREST OF NATIONAL DEFENSE.

APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE UNDERWATER EXPLOSION TESTS ON SUBMERGED LANDS OF MONO LAKE, MONO COUNTY; UNITED STATES OF AMERICA - W.O 4318.

On October 26, 1961, the Commission authorized the approval of a six-month right-of-entry permit authorizing the United States of America to conduct underwater explosion tests in Mono Lake, Mono County, for national defense purposes. Due to technical difficulties, the testing programs will not be completed within the authorized six-month term, which ends April 30, 1962. Therefore, the United States of America has requested an additional ten months, which will expire February 28, 1963, within which to conduct further seismic studies in Mono Lake.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE A TEN-MONTH RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMIT, EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 1962, AUTHORIZING THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA TO CONDUCT UNDERWATER EXPLOSION TESTS IN MONO LAKE, MONO COUNTY, IN THE INTEREST OF NATIONAL DEFENSE.
