

MINUTE ITEM

4. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN DRAINAGE CHANNEL ACROSS STATE TIDELANDS IN SAN PABLO BAY, MARIN COUNTY; LAS GALLINAS VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT - W.O. 4362, P.R.C. 2882.9 (A), (B).

After consideration of Calendar Item 17 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE LAS GALLINAS VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT:

1. A PERMIT TO DREDGE A CHANNEL IN SAN PABLO BAY, MARIN COUNTY, BY REMOVING APPROXIMATELY 60,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM AN AREA DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, AND DEPOSITING SAID MATERIAL ON TIDELANDS ABOUT 1500 FEET NORTHERLY THEREOF:

A STRIP OF LAND 100 FEET WIDE WITHIN SECTIONS 11 AND 12, T. 2 N., R. 6 W., AND SECTION 7, T. 2 N., R. 5 W., M.D.B. & M., LYING ADJACENT TO AND NORTHERLY OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED LINE:

BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE LANDS OF THE ST. VINCENT'S ROMAN CATHOLIC ORPHAN ASYLUM OF SAN FRANCISCO FOR BOYS AS DESCRIBED IN THAT CERTAIN DEED DATED MARCH 2, 1946 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 513 AT PAGE 1, MARIN COUNTY RECORDS, SAID POINT BEING THE INTERSECTION OF THE EASTLY LINE OF LOCATION NO. 175, STATE TIDE LANDS, DESCRIBED AS PARCEL SIX IN SAID DEED AND THE LINE DESIGNATED "LIMIT OF JURISDICTION OF THE TIDE LAND COMMISSION" AS SHOWN ON THAT CERTAIN MAP ENTITLED "MAP NO. 3, SALT MARSH AND TIDE LANDS" SURVEYED BY G. F. ALLARDT IN 1870; RUNNING THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING NORTHEASTERLY AND EASTERLY ALONG SAID LINE DESIGNATED AS "LIMIT OF JURISDICTION OF TIDE LAND COMMISSION" 9900 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE LINE DESIGNATED "LINE OF LOWEST TIDE" AS SHOWN ON SAID MAP NO. 3, AND CONTAINING 22.727 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

2. A 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND USE OF THE CHANNEL THUS CREATED.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR ISSUANCE OF THE PERMITS IS TO BE THE PUBLIC BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN DRAINAGE CHANNEL ACROSS STATE TIDELANDS IN SAN PABLO BAY, MARIN COUNTY; LAS GALLINAS VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT - W.O. 4362.

The Las Gallinas Valley Sanitary District, San Rafael, California, has applied for a permit to dredge a drainage channel across the tidelands on the westerly side of San Pablo Bay, Marin County (Exhibit "A"). The channel would be 24 feet wide and would be dredged to a depth of three feet below mean lower low water. The dredge material, amounting to approximately 60,000 cubic yards, would be dispersed on the tidelands about 1500 feet northerly of the channel.

The purpose of the project is to reduce pollution in Gallinas Creek by diverting drainage from an existing sewage treatment plant through the new channel.

The permit consideration is to be the public benefit.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE LAS GALLINAS VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT:

1. A PERMIT TO DREDGE A CHANNEL IN SAN PABLO BAY, MARIN COUNTY, BY REMOVING APPROXIMATELY 60,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM AN AREA DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, AND DEPOSITING SAID MATERIAL ON TIDELANDS ABOUT 1500 FEET NORTHERLY THEREOF:
