

MINUTE ITEM

4. APPLICATION FOR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN FRANCISCO COUNTY; RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO - W.O. 4399, P.R.C. 2896.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 6 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT TO THE RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF SAN FRANCISCO FOR THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LANDS:

A PARCEL OF SUBMERGED LAND IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN FRANCISCO COUNTY, LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 1,200 FEET NORTHWESTERLY FROM THE INTERSECTION OF FILLMORE STREET AND MARINA BOULEVARD IN THE CITY OF SAN FRANCISCO, AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT IN THE N. S. BULKHEAD LINE AS SHOWN ON THE MAP ENTITLED "SAN FRANCISCO BAY, CALIFORNIA, HARBOR LINES, SAN FRANCISCO" APPROVED 28 JUNE, 1948, WHICH POINT BEARS N. 82° 05' 01" E., 2341.60 FEET FROM STATION 1 OF SAID BULKHEAD LINE; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING N. 22° 05' 02" E., 500.88 FEET; THENCE S. 67° 54' 58" E., 270.00 FEET; THENCE S. 22° 05' 02" W., 345.00 FEET; THENCE S. 82° 05' 01" W., 311.71 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, AND CONTAINING 2.62 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT IS TO BE THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR SUBMERGED LANDS OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN FRANCISCO COUNTY; RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO - W.O. 4399.

The Recreation and Park Department of the City and County of San Francisco has applied for a life-of-structure permit covering 2.62 acres of submerged land of San Francisco Bay approximately 1200 feet northwesterly from the intersection of Fillmore Street and Marina Boulevard in the City of San Francisco (see Exhibit "A"), to be used to extend the existing breakwater approximately 440 feet in a northeasterly direction, to make the existing municipal water park more available for the berthing and operation of small boats.

A legislative restriction limits the use of the area to park purposes. Staff Counsel concurs with the opinion of the City Attorney of San Francisco that the proposed use for this area falls within that classification.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT TO THE RECREATION AND PARK DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF SAN FRANCISCO FOR THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LANDS:

A PARCEL OF SUBMERGED LAND IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, SAN FRANCISCO COUNTY, LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 1,200 FEET NORTHWESTERLY FROM THE INTERSECTION OF FILLMORE STREET AND MARINA BOULEVARD IN THE CITY OF SAN FRANCISCO, AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT IN THE U. S. BULKHEAD LINE AS SHOWN ON THE MAP ENTITLED "SAN FRANCISCO BAY, CALIFORNIA, HARBOR LINES, SAN FRANCISCO" APPROVED 28 JUNE, 1948, WHICH POINT BEARS N. 82° 05' 01" E., 231.60 FEET FROM STATION 1 OF SAID BULKHEAD LINE; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING N. 22° 05' 02" E., 500.88 FEET; THENCE S. 67° 54' 58" E., 270.00 FEET; THENCE S. 22° 05' 02" W., 345.00 FEET; THENCE S. 82° 05' 01" W., 311.76 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, AND CONTAINING 2.62 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT IS TO BE THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.
