

MINUTE ITEM

2. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO MAKE TEST BORINGS ON STATE SOVEREIGN LANDS OF LOWER ALKALI LAKE, MIDDLE ALKALI LAKE, AND UPPER ALKALI LAKE, MODOC COUNTY; U. S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS - W.O. 4617, P.R.C. 2971.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 8 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE U. S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS A ONE-YEAR PERMIT TO MAKE TEST BORINGS ON THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LAND:

THOSE PORTIONS OF THE BEDS OF LOWER ALKALI LAKE, MIDDLE ALKALI LAKE, AND UPPER ALKALI LAKE SITUATE IN THE COUNTY OF MODOC, STATE OF CALIFORNIA WITHIN TOWNSHIPS 41, 42, 43, 44, 45 AND 46 N., R. 16 E., TOWNSHIPS 39, 40, 41, 42 AND 45 N., R. 17 E., M.D.M., WITHIN THE LOW WATER MARKS OF THE NATURAL LAKE BEDS, EMBRACING 76,568 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT IS THE INTERESTS OF NATIONAL DEFENSE.

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO MAKE TEST BORINGS ON STATE SOVEREIGN LANDS OF LOWER ALKALI LAKE, MIDDLE ALKALI LAKE, AND UPPER ALKALI LAKE, MODOC COUNTY; U. S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS - W.O. 4617.

The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers has applied for a permit to make test borings of State sovereign lands comprising the beds of Lower Alkali Lake, Middle Alkali Lake, and Upper Alkali Lake, a total of 76,568 acres more or less (see Exhibit "A").

The drilling is to be accomplished by landing small planes with necessary drilling equipment. Each test will take from three to four days, after which the land will be restored to its natural condition. The purpose of these tests is to analyze soil characteristics in the region; a copy of the test report will be furnished the State. All drilling will be in compliance with all rules and regulations now promulgated by any agency of the State of California having jurisdiction therein.

The permit is to be for one year, the consideration to be the interests of national defense.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE U. S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS A ONE-YEAR PERMIT TO MAKE TEST BORINGS ON THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LAND:
