## MINUTE ITEM

3. APPLICATION FOR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT OVER STATE SOVEREIGN LANDS OF AMERICAN RIVER AT CITY OF SACRAMENTO, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT - W.O. 4702, P.R.C. 3000.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 12 attached, and upon motion duly male and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE SECTION 12808, THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT A LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND USE OF A POWER LINE OVER THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LANDS:

A STRIP OF LAND 10 FEET WIDE IN THE BED OF THE AMERICAN RIVER WITHIN SECTION 7, T. 8 N., R. 6 E., M.D.B.& M. AND SECTION 60 OF RANCHO DEL PASO, RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF SACRAMENTO COUNTY ON MARCH 4, 1911, IN BOCK A OF SURVEYS, MAP NO. 94, THE CENTERLINE OF SAID STRIP BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BECINNING AT A POINT ON THE MEAN LOW WATER LINE ALONG THE SOUTHERLY BANK OF THE AMERICAN RIVER, SAID POINT BEING THE NORTHEASTERLY CORNER OF THAT CERTAIN "RECORD OF SURVEY OF A PORTION OF SECTION 12, T. 8 N., R. 5 E., AND SECTION 7, T. 8 N., R. 6 E., M.D.B.& M.", RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF SACRAMENTO COUNTY ON DECEMBER 15, 1960, IN BOCK 17 OF SURVEYS AT PAGE 12; THENCE, FROM SAID POINT OF BECINNING NORTH 12° 27' 56" WEST 401.7 FEET TO A POINT ON THE MEAN LOW WATER LINE ALONG THE NORTHERLY BANK OF THE AMERICAN RIVER.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE PERMIT IS TO BE THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.

## CALENDAR ITEM

APPLICATION FOR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT OVER STATE SOVEREIGN LANDS OF AMERICAN RIVER AT CLTY OF SACRAMENTO, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT - W.O. 4702.

The Sacramento Municipal Utility District has applied for a life-of-structure permit covering 0.092 acre more or less of State sovereign lands of the Sacramento River at the City of Sacramento (see Exhibit "A"). This permit is for a new 12 KV power line which will tie together two existing power lines to provide better service for the easterly section of greater Sacramento.

The Public Utilities Code Section 12808 provides as follows:

"A district may construct works across or along any street or public highway, or over any of the lands which are the property of the State, and it shall have the same rights and privileges appertaining thereto as are granted to municipalities within the State. The district shall restore any such street or highway to its former state as near as may be, and in compliance with local ordinances, and shall not use it in a manner to unnecessarily impair its usefulness. A district may also construct its works across any stream or watercourse."

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE SECTION 12808, THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT A LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND USE OF A POWER LINE OVER THE FOLLOWING-ASCRIBED LANDS:

A STRIP OF LAND 10 FEET WIDE IN THE BED OF THE AMERICAN RIVER WITHIN SECTION 7, T. 8 N., R. 6 E., M.D.B.& M. AND SECTION 60 OF RANCHO DEL PASO, RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF SACRAMENTO COUNTY ON MARCH 4, 1911, IN BOOK A OF SURVEYS, MAP NO. 94, THE CENTERLINE OF SAID STRIP BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE MEAN LOW WATER LINE ALONG THE SOUTHERLY BANK OF THE AMERICAN RIVER, SAID POINT BEING THE NORTHEASTERLY CORNER OF THAT CERTAIN "RECORD OF SURVEY OF A PORTION OF SECTION 12, T. 8 N., R. 5 E., AND SECTION 7, T. 8 N., R. 6 E., M.D.B.& M.", RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF SACRAMENTO COUNTY ON DECEMBER 15, 1960, IN BOOK 17 OF SURVEYS AT PAGE 12; THENCE, FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING NORTH 12° 27' 56" WEST 401.7 FEET TO A POINT ON THE MEAN LOW WATER LINE ALONG THE NORTHERLY BANK OF THE AMERICAN RIVER.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE PERMIT IS TO BE THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.
