7. APPLICATION FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY OVER SCHOOL LAND IN $NW_{\overline{u}}^{1}$ OF SECTION 16, T. 12 S., R. 20 E., S.B.B.& M., IMPERIAL COUNTY; DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS - W.O. 4518, P.R.C. 3010.2.

After consideration of Calendar Item 8 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND PROTECTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 146 OVER A PORTION OF SCHOOL LAND IN IMPERIAL COUNTY FOR A CONSIDERATION OF \$100. THE AREA IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

THAT PORTION OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 20 EAST, S.B.M., ACCORDING TO U. S. GOVERNMENT SURVEY APPROVED FEBRUARY 13, 1919, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 16; THENCE ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID SECTION 16, S. 1° 42' 40" E., 777.47 FEET; THENCE LEAVING SAID WEST LINE N. 21° 52' 50" E., 128.25 FEET; THENCE ALONG A TANGENT CURVE TO THE RIGHT HAVING A RADIUS OF 4,800 FEET THROUGH AN ANGLE OF 7° 52' 08", A DISTANCE OF 659.22 FEET; THENCE N. 29° 44' 58" E., 85.36 FEET TO THE NORTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 16; THENCE ALONG SAID NORTH LINE S. 88° 42' 58" W., 400.31 FEET TO THE POILT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 3.33 ACRES.

APPLICATION FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY OVER SCHOOL LAND IN NW_b^1 OF SECTION 16, T. 12 S., R. 20 E., S.B.B.& M., IMPERIAL COUNTY; DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS - W.O. 4518.

An application has been received from the Division of Highways for a right-of-way for the construction and protection of State Highway Route 146, a conventional highway, over the extreme northwesterly portion of Section 16, T. 12 S., R. 20 E., S.B.B.& M., in Imperial County (see Exhibits "A" and "B"). The proposed easement is south of Blythe, about midway between Palo Verde and Glamis, in a remote, rough, arid area. It encompasses 3.33 acres and has been valued at \$30 an acre or a total of \$100. There will be no severance damage, nor is there any problem of access from the new highway to the remaining school land.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND PROTECTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 146 OVER A PORTION OF SCHOOL LAND IN IMPERIAL COUNTY FOR A CONSIDERATION OF \$100. THE AREA IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
