After consideration of Calendar Item 19 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION APPROVES COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, AS INDICATED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND HERERY MADE A PART HEREOF, FOR THE PERIOD JUNE 27, 1963, TO TERMINATION DATE; SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS, HOWEVER, THAT THE AMOUNTS, IF ANY, OF EACH OF THE ITEMS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COSTS, DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 5(%) OF CHAPTER 29, STATUTES OF 1956, LST E.S., WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TYME WHEN THE WORK UNDER ANY OF THESE ITEMS IS COMPLETED; THAT THE WORK CONFORM IN ESSENTIAL DETAILS TO THE PLANS AND BACKGROUND MATERIAL HERETOFORE SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSION. FURTHER, THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, THE ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE SUPERVISING MINERAL RESOURCES ENGINEER ARE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.

CONSIDERATION OF SUBSIDENCE COSTS PROJECTS, LONG BEACH - L.B.W.O. 10,115; L.B.W.O. 10,123; L.B.W.O. 10,127; L.B.W.O. 10,128.

On June 23, 1960, the Commission conditionally approved the costs to be expended by the Harbor Department of the City of Long Beach, including subsidence remedial work, for the Pier "A", the Pier "2", the Roads and Streets, and the Town Lot Area projects. Subsequent to the above-stated approval, it developed that additional costs will be incurred by the Harbor Department. These costs will cover the construction of an earth ramp at Berth 5 and a boat landing at Berth 11 on Pier "A" (L.B.W.O. 10,115); a water line reconnection at Pier "2" (L.B.W.O. 10,123); a water line on Pico Avenue between 9th and 3rd Streets, Roads and Streets (L.B.W.O. 10,127); and a storm drain at Pico Avenue and Seaside Boulevard, Town Lot (L.B.W.O. 10,128). Refer to Exhibits "A", "B", "C", and "D" attached.

These subprojects have received initial staff review and are considered to contain some "subsidence costs" as defined in Section 1(f) of Chapter 29, Statutes of 1956, lst E.S., but not necessarily all of those costs as estimated by the City of Long Beach.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION APPROVE COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, AS INDICATED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND HEREBY MADE A PART EEREOF, FOR THE PERIOD JUNE 27, 1963, TO TERMINATION DATE; SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS, HOWEVER, THAT THE AMOUNTS, IF ANY, OF EACH OF THE ITEMS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COSTS, DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 5(a) OF CHAPTER 29, STATUTES OF 1950, LST E.S., WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE WORK UNDER ANY OF THESE ITEMS IN COMPLETED; THAT THE WORK CONFORM IN ESSENTIAL DETAILS TO THE FLANS AND BACKGROUND MATERIAL HERETOFORE SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSION. IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, THE ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE SUPERVISING MINERAL RESOURCES ENGINEER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.


