

MINUTE ITEM

5. APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT COVERING STATE SOVEREIGN LAND, SACRAMENTO RIVER, GLENN COUNTY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME - W.O. 4733, P.R.C. 3049.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 29 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME A 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT COVERING THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED AREA:

THAT STATE LAND UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION OF CALIFORNIA, WITHIN A PARCEL OF LAND IN THE BED OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, GLENN COUNTY; BEING ADJACENT TO THE SOUTH BANK OF THE RIVER, AND SITUATE IN THE VICINITY OF ORD FERRY. SAID PARCEL BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE SOUTH BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER WHICH BEARS N. 70° 41' W. 1,240 FEET, MORE OR LESS, FROM THE CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 5, 6, 7 AND 8 AS PER A MAP "SHOWING THE SUBDIVISIONS OF THE GLENN RANCH, GLENN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA", RECORDED AUGUST 23, 1900 IN BOOK 1 OF MAPS AND SURVEYS AT PAGE 110 RECORDS OF GLENN COUNTY. THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING, PROCEEDING WATERWARD NORTH 220 FEET; S. 72° 00' E. 350 FEET; N. 87° 53' E. 1,150 FEET; N. 59° 54' E. 240 FEET; N. 48° 54' W. 130 FEET; N. 48° 20' E. 575 FEET; S. 86° 54' 13" E. 801.32 FEET; THENCE S. 6° 19' E. 50 FEET TO THE AFOREMENTIONED SOUTH BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER; THENCE PROCEEDING ALONG SAID BANK S. 46° 54' 54" W. 177.53 FEET; S. 35° 00' W. 500 FEET; S. 50° 00' W. 500 FEET; S. 70° 00' W. 400 FEET; S. 89° 30' W. 300 FEET; N. 82° 30' W. 500 FEET; N. 77° 30' W. 500 FEET; THENCE N. 65° 00' W. 400 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. SAID PARCEL CONTAINING 31 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT WILL BE THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT COVERING STATE SOVEREIGN LAND, SACRAMENTO RIVER, GLENN COUNTY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME - W.O. 4733.

The State Department of Fish and Game has applied for a 49-year life-of-structure permit covering 31 acres more or less of submerged lands of the Sacramento River, for the construction and use of an angling access area (see Exhibit "A").

The structures to be constructed on the State land are a fishing float and ramp which will be moved around within the permit area, and a boat-launching ramp. A parking area, access road, and sanitary facilities are to be constructed on the upland.

The consideration for the issuance of the permit will be the public use and benefit.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME A 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT COVERING THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED AREA:

THAT STATE LAND UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION OF CALIFORNIA, WITHIN A PARCEL OF LAND IN THE BED OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, GLENN COUNTY; BEING ADJACENT TO THE SOUTH BANK OF THE RIVER, AND SITUATE IN THE VICINITY OF ORD FERRY. SAID PARCEL BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING, PROCEEDING WATERWARD NORTH 220 FEET; S. 72° 00' E. 350 FEET; N. 87° 53' E. 1,150 FEET; N. 59° 54' E. 240 FEET; N. 48° 54' W. 130 FEET; N. 48° 20' E. 575 FEET; S. 86° 54' 13" E. 801.32 FEET; THENCE S. 0° 19' E. 50 FEET TO THE AFOREMENTIONED SOUTH BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER; THENCE PROCEEDING ALONG SAID BANK S. 46° 54' 54" W. 177.53 FEET; S. 35° 00' W. 500 FEET; S. 50° 00' W. 500 FEET; S. 70° 00' W. 400 FEET; S. 89° 30' W. 300 FEET; N. 82° 30' W. 500 FEET; N. 77° 30' W. 500 FEET; THENCE N. 65° 00' W. 400 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
