

MINUTE ITEM

13. APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR EASEMENT FOR A TRANSMISSION WIRE TO CROSS TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF BURNS CUT-OFF, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA; PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY - W.O. 4861, P.R.C. 3066.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 13 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY A 49-YEAR WIRE-CROSSING EASEMENT, FOR A TOTAL RENT OF \$1,150.03, PAYABLE IN ADVANCE, OVER TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN BURNS CUT-OFF, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, DESCRIBED AS:

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND 40 FEET WIDE IN BURNS CUT-OFF, WEST OF THE ROUGH AND READY ISLAND NAVAL RESERVATION, AND LYING 20 FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED LINE:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE HIGH WATER MARK ON THE EAST BANK OF BURNS CUT-OFF WHICH BEARS N. 58° 52' 30" W., 5,984.36 FEET AND S. 51° 18' W., 110 FEET FROM U.S.E. TRIANGULATION STATION "DAG." HAVING ZONE III LAMBERT COORDINATES OF X = 1,753,186.67, Y = 525,671.40, THENCE S. 51° 18" W. 275 FEET TO A POINT ON THE HIGH WATER MARK ON THE WEST BANK OF BURNS CUT-OFF, CONTAINING 0.25 ACRE, MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR EASEMENT FOR A TRANSMISSION WIRE TO CROSS TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF BURNS CUT-OFF, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA; PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY - W.O. 4861.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company has applied for a 40-foot-wide easement crossing 0.25 acre more or less of tide and submerged lands in Burns Cut-off near Jacobs Bridge, approximately  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles west of Stockton, San Joaquin County (see Exhibits "A" and "B").

The easement is to be used for the construction and maintenance of an overhead wire, which will service a pumping station that supplies fuel for high-performance aircraft. The line is to have an 80-foot minimum clearance over mean high water level.

The recommended term of the easement is to be 49 years, at a total rent of \$1,150.03, payable in advance.

HAVING ZONE III LAMBERT COORDINATES OF  $X = 1,753,186.67$ ,  $Y = 525,671.40$ , THENCE S.  $51^{\circ} 18''$  W. 275 FEET TO A POINT ON THE HIGH WATER MARK ON THE WEST BANK OF BURNS CUT-OFF, CONTAINING 0.25 ACRE, MORE OR LESS.
