## MINUTE ITEM

34. LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD - L.B.W.O. 10,155.

The Chairman reported that the Commission had been invited to meet that afternoon with the Long Beach City Council, with the Long Beach Eoard of Harbor Commissioners also to be in attendance and to participate, to discuss the proposed operating contract for the East Wilmington Field.

This meeting with the Council is for the purpose of attempting to resolve the matters presently at issue which have resulted from differences in contractual viewpoints of the City and the State.

Upon motion duly made and carried unanimously, the following resolution was adopted as a statement of the present position of the Lands Commission:

THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION LEREBY EXPRESSES ITS DESIRE TO ENTER INTO A POINT-BY-POINT REVIEW OF THE POINTS AT ISSUE WITH THE CITY COUNCIL OF LONG BEACH IN REGARD TO THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF THE EAST LONG BEACH WILMINGTON OIL FIELD. IT IS THE SUGGESTION OF THE LANDS COMMISSION THAT THIS REVIEW BE COMMENCED AT THE STAFF LEVEL, AND THE COMMISSION HEREBY AUTHORIZES THE COMMISSION'S STAFF TO MEET WITH THE CITY COUNCIL'S STAFF FOR THIS PURPOSE AT A MUTUALLY CONVENIENT TIME SUBSEQUENT TO THIS AFTERNOON'S JOINT COMMISSION-COUNCIL SESSION.
