MINUTE ITEM

3. EAST WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LONG BEACH, LOS ANGELES CCUNTY - L.B.W.O. 10,155.

The Chairman reported receipt from Senator Fred Farr, Chairman of the Senate Fact Finding Committee on Natural Resources, of a resolution requesting the Lands Commission not to approve any contracts for the production of oil, gas, and other hydrocarbons from tide and submerged lands deeded in trust by the State to the City of Long Beach until the Senate has considered the subject of this resolution in Extraordinary Session in 1964.

As the Commission did not have any contract before it, no formal action was necessary, and Senator Farr has been so informed. Discussions have been neld between the staffs of the Commission and the City of Long Beach.

In response to a question raised by Mr. H. A. Lingle, Deputy City Attorney of Long Beach, as to whether there was any point in the staffs continuing to work together on the contract, the Chairman indicated that it would appear to be to the benefit of both parties to work toward agreement, but noted that the Commission would have to recognize the Legislature's consideration of changing Chapter 29, Statutes of 1956, First E.
