## MINUTE ITEM

11. APPLICATION FOR DREDGING PERMIT, NOYO RIVER, MENDOCINO COUNTY; EVERETT S. HAMMAN - W.O. 5008, P.R.C. 3127.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 25 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO EVERETT S. HAMMAN A PERMIT TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 500 CUBIC YARDS OF SAND, SILT, A) RAVEL, AT A ROYALTY OF \$0.06 PER CUBIC YARD FOR ALL MATERIAL REMOVED, FROM A PORTION OF THE BED OF THE NOYO RIVER, AND TO DEPOSIT THE MATERIAL ON ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNED BY THE APPLICANT; EXTRACTION OPERATIONS TO BE RESTRICTED TO THE PERIOD JUNE 15 THROUGH ONTOPER 1, 1964. THE PORTION OF THE NOYO RIVER TO BE DREDGED IS WITHIN THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED AREA:

FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7, T. 18 N., H. 17 W., M.D.M., PROCEED N. 78° 13' E. 3406.4 FEET TO A POINT IN THE NOYO RIVER, SAID POINT BEING THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE S. 78° E. 200 FHET; THENCE S. 12° W. 66 FEET; THENCE N. 78° W. 200 FEET; THENCE N. 12° E. 66 FEET, TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING CONJAINING .30 ACRE MORE OR LESS, IN MENDOCINO COUNTY.

## CALENDAR ITEM

APPLICATION FOR DREDGING PERMIT, NOYO RIVER, MENDOCINO COUNTY; EVEFETT S. HAMMAN - W.G. 5008.

An application has been received from Everett S. Hamman for a permit to dredge approximately 500 cubic yards of sand, silt, and gravel from the bed of the Noyo River, approximately one and one-half miles upstream from the Pacific Ocean, in Mendocino County.

The dredging is to be for the purpose of erosion and flood control, to obtain material for road surfacing on nearby property owned by the applicant, and for stabilization of the river bank in the vicinity of the removal area, which is presently being eroded.

Section 6303 of the Fublic Resources Code provides, in part: "When a... permittee has a...permit from the Federal Government or any authorized public agency to dredge...for the improvement of navigation...the Commission may, when in the best interests of the State, allow such...permittee to have sand, gravel, or other spoils dredged from the sovereign lands of the State located within the area specified in such permit upon such consideration as will be in the best interests of the State..."

The U. S. Corps of Engineers has issued a Department of the Army permit authorizing the conduct of dredging operations at the location described in the application. The Division of Beaches and Parks has reported that the proposed operations will not affect its park program; the Department of Fish and Game has recommended that, if a permit is issued, the operation be restricted to the period June 15 through October 1, 1964.

The \$5 filing fee has been paid by the applicant.

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IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO EVERETT S. HAMMAN A HERMIT TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 500 CUBIC YARDS OF SAND, SILT, AND GRAVEL, AT A REYALTY OF \$0.06 PER CUBIC YARD FOR ALL MATERIAL REMOVED, FROM A PORTION OF THE BED OF THE NOYO RIVER, AND TO DEPOSIT THE MATERIAL ON ADJACENT PROFFERTY CWNED BY THE APPLICANT; EXTRAC-TION OPERATIONS TO BE RESTRICTED TO THE PERIOD JUNE 15 THROUGH OCTOBER 1, 1964. THE PORTION OF THE NOYO RIVER TO BE DREDGED IS WITHIN THE FOLLOWINC-DESCRIBED AREA:

FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7, T. 18 N., R. 17 W., M.D.M., PROCEED N. 78° 13' E. 3406.4 FEET TO A POINT IN THE NOYO RIVER, SAID FOINT BEING THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE S. 78° E. 200 FEET; THENCE S. 12° W. 66 FEET; THENCE N 78° W. 200 FEET; THENCE N. 12° E. 66 FEET, TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING CONTAINING .30 ACRE MORE OR LESS, IN MENDOCINO COUNTY.

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
