THE COMMISSION FINDS THAT THE SW_{5}^{1} OF SE_{4}^{1} AND E_{2}^{1} OF SE_{4}^{1} OF SECTION 17; SE_{4}^{1} OF NE_{4}^{1} AND NE_{4}^{1} OF SE_{4}^{1} OF SECTION 20; LOTS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 12 AND 13 OF SECTION 21; LOTS 7, 9, 10 AND 16 OF SECTION 22; ALL IN T. 8 S., R. 4 E., M.D.M., CONTAINING 645.33 ACRES IN SANTA CLAHA COUNTY, IS NOT SUITABLE FOR CULTIVATION WITHOUT ARTIFICIAL IRRIGATION, AND AUTHORIZES THE SALE OF SAID LAND TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, PUBLIC WORKS BOARD, WITHOUT ADVERTISING, SUBJECT TO ALL CONSTITUTIONAL AND STATUTORY RESERVATIONS INCLULING MINERALS, AT THE APPEALSED CASH PRICE OF \$22,586.55.

An offer has been received from the State of California, Public Works Board, to purchase the $SW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ of $SE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ and $E_{\frac{1}{2}}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $SE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of $SE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ and $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of $SE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 20; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 12 and 13 of Section 21; Lots 7, 9, 10 and 16 of Section 22; all in T. 8 S., R. 4 E., M.D.M., containing 645.33 acres in Santa Clara County. The applicant made an offer of \$1,290.66, cr \$2 per acre, the minimum amount required by law.

The above-described land adjoins Henry W. Coe State Park and is within the area proposed for addition to the park.

A staff appraisel shows that the land is not suitable for cultivation without artificial irrigation and establishes its value at an average of \$35 per acre, or a total of \$22,586.55.
