## MINUTE ITEM

3. APPLICATION FOR EASEMENT FOR LOCATION OF A SUBMARINE COAXIAL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH CABLE, CROSSING TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF ESTERO BAY AND THE PACIFIC OCEAN, SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY; AMERICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY - W.O. 5092, P.R.C. 3135.9

After consideration of Calendar Item 6 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE AMARICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7901 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND OF ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OPINION NO. 52,56, IN THE FORM PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION, APPROVING THE LOCATION OF A SUBMARINE COAXIAL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH CABLE WITH THE NECESSARY APPURTENANCES, ACROSS THE UNGRANTED TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS DESCRIBED AS:

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN ESTERO BAY AND THE PACIFIC OCEAN, IN SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY, LYING 50 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTERLINE:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH WIDE LINE OF ESTERO BAY LOCATED 50 FEET SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, M.D.B.& M., WITH THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF ESTERO BAY; THENCE NORTH 84° 48' WEST, 6323.35 FEET AND THENCE SOUTH 77° 12' WEST, 28,881 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE SEAWARD BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 80.818 ACRES.

APPLICATION FOR EASEMENT FOR LOCATION OF A SUBMARINE COAXIAL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH CABLE, CROSSING TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF ESTERO BAY AND THE PACIFIC OCEAN, SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY; AMERICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY - W.O. 5092.

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, acting as agent for American Telephone and Telegraph Company, has applied for approval of an easement across ungranted tide and submerged lands approximately two miles south of Morro Bay, San Luis Obispo County (see Exhibit "A").

The proposed crossing, 100 feet wide and approximately 35,204 feet in length, containing approximately 80.818 acres, is for location of a submarine coaxial telephone and telegraph cable, together with necessary appurtenances thereto.

The Commission previously adopted the "Approval of Location Agreement Form" used for telephone and telegraph facilities crossing State lands, in accordance with Section 7901 of the Public Utilities Code and with Attorney General's Opinion No. 52/56.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE AMERICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7901 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND OF ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OPINION NO. 52/56, IN THE FORM PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION, APPROVING THE LOCATION OF A SUBMARINE COAXIAL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH CABLE WITH THE NECESSARY APPURTENANCES, ACROSS THE UNGRANTED TILE AND SUBMERGED LANDS DESCRIBED AS:

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN ESTERO BAY AND THE PACIFIC OCEAN, IN SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY, LYING 50 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTERLINE:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF ESTERO BAY LOCATED 50 FEET SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, M.D.B.& M., WITH THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF ESTERO BAY; THENCE NORTH 84° 48' WEST, 6323.35 FEET AND THENCE SOUTH 77° 12' WEST, 28,881 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE SEAWARD BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 80.818 ACRES.
