MINUTE ITEM

3. APPLICATION BY COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO FOR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT ON STATE-OWNED SUBMERCED LAND OF SACRAMENTO RIVER NEAR WALNUT GROVE, SACRAMENTO COUNTY - W.O. 5268, P.R.C. 3188.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 29 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO A LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A 6-INCH CAST IRON SUBMARINE FORCE MAIN ACROSS SUBMERGED LAND OF SACRAMENTO RIVER, THE CONSIDERATION TO BE THE PUBLIC BENEFIT. THE LAND IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND 50 FEET WIDE IN THE BED OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, SITUATE NEAR WALNUT GROVE, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; BEING 25 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTER LINE:

BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ON THE EAST BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER WITH A LINE HAVING A BEARLIG OF N. 49° 24' 31" W. A POINT ON SAID LINE BEARS N. 31° 55' 05" E. AND IS DISTANT 543.57 FEET FROM A STATE BOARD OF RECLAMATION BRASS CAP MONUMENT STAMPED SL-57A; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF INTERSECTION N. 49° 24' 31" W. 320 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ON THE WEST BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER; CONTAINING 0.367 ACRE MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION BY COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO FOR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT ON STATE-OWNED SUBMERGED LAND OF SACRAMENTO RIVER NEAR WALNUT GROVE, SACRAMENTO COUNTY - W.O. 5268.

By letter dated July 29, 1964, the County of Sacramento, Department of Public Works has requested a life-of-structure permit. The letter states that: "A sewer assessment district is being formed to provide sewage collection and treatment facilities for the City of Walnut Grove and the Clampett Tract area. Included as part of the construction is a 6-inch cast iron submarine force main across the Sacramento River approximately 530 feet northeast of the Walnut Grove Bridge." (See Exhibit "A".)

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO A LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A 6-INCH CAST IRON SUBMARINE FORCE MAIN ACROSS SUBMERGED LAND OF SACRAMENTO RIVER, THE CONSIDERATION TO BE THE PUBLIC BENEFIT. THE LAND IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND 50 FEET WIDE IN THE BED OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, SITUATE NEAR WALNUT GROVE, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; BEING 25 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTER LINE:

BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ON THE EAST BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER WITH A LINE HAVING A BEARING OF N. 49° 24' 31" W. A POINT ON SAID LINE BEARS N. 31° 55' 05" E. AND IS DISTANT 543.5" FEET FROM A STATE BOARD OF RECLAMATION BRASS CAP MONUMENT STAMPED SL-57A; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF INTERSECTION N. 49° 24' 31" W. 320 FEET, MORE OR LESS. TO THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ON THE WEST BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO PIVER; CONTAINING 0.367 ACRE MORE OR LESS.
