Signal Oil and Gas Company, a Delaware corporation, is the owner of the 100% working interest in State Oil and Gas Lease P.R.C. 392.1, issued on September 26, 1938, to Southwest Exploration Company pursuant to competitive public bidding in accordance with applicable law. An application has been received from Signal Oil and Gas Company for approval of the assignment of an undivided interest in Lease P.R.C. 392.1 to each of the following: Pauley Petroleum Inc., Edwin W.
