

MINUTE ITEM

9. APPLICATION FOR NONCOMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND, SACRAMENTO RIVER, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; HARRY W. ERICKSON - W.O. 5440, P.R.C. 3231.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 7 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO HARRY W. ERICKSON, FOR THE FEE OF \$25, A FIVE-YEAR NONCOMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A MOORING PIER ON LANDS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN THE BED OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER ADJACENT SOUTHERLY TO A BERM KNOWN AS LONG ISLAND, BEING ALSO IN THE VICINITY OF ISLETON, SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA; SAID PARCEL BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT U.S.C. & G.S. TRIANGULATION STATION ISLETON 1931, HAVING CALIFORNIA ZONE 2 COORDINATES OF  $X = 2,109,469.25$ ,  $Y = 182,049.15$ ; THENCE N.  $66^{\circ} 04'$  W. 270.20 FEET, S.  $0^{\circ} 23'$  E. 291.00 FEET, S.  $73^{\circ} 05'$  E. 287.79 FEET, AND THENCE S.  $72^{\circ} 42'$  E. 167.50 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, SAID POINT BEING ON THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE NORTH BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER; THENCE LEAVING THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK S.  $17^{\circ} 18'$  W. 95.00 FEET, S.  $72^{\circ} 42'$  E. 155.00 FEET, N.  $17^{\circ} 18'$  E. 104.00 FEET TO THE ABOVE-MENTIONED ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK; THENCE ALONG SAID ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK N.  $81^{\circ} 14'$  W. 60.68 FEET, AND N.  $72^{\circ} 42'$  W. 95.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; CONTAINING 0.344 ACRE MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR NONCOMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND, SACRAMENTO RIVER, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; HARRY W. ERICKSON - W.O. 5440.

Harry W. Erickson, owner of the adjacent upland, has applied for a non-commercial minor-structure permit to construct a 4-foot by 75-foot mooring pier and dolphins on 0.344 acre more or less of State-owned tide and submerged lands of the Sacramento River, at River Mile 17.0 adjacent southerly to a berm known as Long Island in the vicinity of Isleton, Sacramento County (see Exhibit "A").

Mr. Erickson has applied for a Department of the Army permit for the pier.

The \$5 filing fee and the \$25 permit fee have been received.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO HARRY W. ERICKSON, FOR THE FEE OF \$25, A FIVE-YEAR NONCOMMERCIAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A MOORING PIER ON LANDS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

TRIANGULATION STATION ISLETON 1931, HAVING CALIFORNIA ZONE 2 COORDINATES OF X = 2,109,469.25, Y = 182,049.15; THENCE N. 66° 04' W. 270.20 FEET, S. 0° 23' E. 291.00 FEET, S. 73° 05' E. 287.79 FEET, AND THENCE S. 72° 42' E. 167.50 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, SAID POINT BEING ON THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE NORTH BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER; THENCE LEAVING THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK S. 17° 18' W. 95.00 FEET, S. 72° 42' E. 155.00 FEET, N. 17° 18' E. 104.00 FEET TO THE ABOVE-MENTIONED ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK; THENCE ALONG SAID ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK N. 81° 14' W. 60.68 FEET, AND N. 72° 42' W. 95.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; CONTAINING 0.344 ACRE MORE OR LESS.
