MINUTE ITEM

34. PROPOSED LEGISLATION AFFECTING TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS - W.O. 4550.11 AND W.O. 4900.

After consideration of Calendar Item 33 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO SUGGEST THE INTRODUCTION OF AN AMEND-MENT TO SECTION 6305, FUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, TO REQUIRE THAT THE CONDITIONS OF DIVISION 6 OF THE FUBLIC RESOURCES CODE AS ADMINISTRATED BY THE COMMIS-SION ALSO BE APPLICABLE TO GRAPTED TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS AS STATED IN THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A".

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PROPOSED LEGISLATION AFFECTING TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS - W.O. 4550.11 AND W.O. 4900.

In supplement to the forcgoing item relative to proposed legislation affecting tide and submerged lands, it is suggested that the Commission recommend to the Legislature consideration of the following legislation. The proposed bill would establish standards for administration of granted tide and submerged lands compatible with the administration by the Commission on ungranted tide and submerged lands. This compatibility could be accomplished during legislative studies to provide an effective basis for future tideland grants, by the requirement that the conditions of Division 6 of the Public Resources Code, as administrated by the Commission, also apply to granted tide and submerged lands.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO SUGGEST THE INTRODUCTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 6305, PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, TO REQUIRE THAT THE CONDITIONS OF DIVISION 6 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE AS ADMINISTRATED BY THE COMMISSION ALSO BE APPLICABLE TO GRANTED TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS AS STATED IN THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A".

EXHIBIT "A"

An act to amend Section 6305 of the Public Resources Code, relating to administration of tide and submerged lands granted to counties, cities and districts.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows;

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Section 1. Section 6305 of the Public Resources Code is amended to read:

6305. The powers granted by this chapter and this division to the commission as to leasing or granting of rights or privileges with relation to such lands owned by the State are hereby conferred upon the counties, and cities and districts to which such lands have been granted, and such powers shall be exercised by said counties, cities and districts in a manner consistent with Division 6 of the Public Resources Code, any other statute, ordinance or law to the contrary notwithstanding.

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
