

MINUTE ITEM

9. APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO LOCATE FISH PASSAGE FACILITIES IN THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, AT RIVER MILE 23.50, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES - W.O. 5551, P.R.C. 3287.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 35 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES A PERMIT TO LOCATE FISH PASSAGE FACILITIES FOR A PERIOD BEGINNING APRIL 1, 1965, AND ENDING OCTOBER 15, 1967, ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A STRIP OF LAND 20 FEET WIDE IN THE BED OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, SACRAMENTO COUNTY, LYING ADJACENT TO THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE EASTERLY BANK OF SAID RIVER AND ADJACENT TO AND EXTENDING NORTHERLY 320 FEET FROM AN EAST-WEST LINE WHICH INTERSECTS THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE EAST BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER AT A POINT WHICH BEARS S. 21° E. 3,350 FEET MORE OR LESS FROM U.S.C. & G.S. TRIANGULATION STATION "RYDEWATER TANK 1931", SAID STATION HAVING CALIFORNIA ZONE 3 COORDINATES OF X = 1,695,884.21, Y = 634,388.38; SAID STRIP OF LAND CONTAINING 0.147 ACRE.

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO LOCATE FISH PASSAGE FACILITIES IN THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, AT RIVER MILE 23.50, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES - W.O. 5551.

Application has been received from the Department of Water Resources to locate fish-passage facilities on tide and submerged lands adjacent to the left bank of the Sacramento River at Mile 23.50, Sacramento County (see Exhibit "A"), for the period beginning April 1, 1965, and ending October 15, 1967.

The structures will consist of a timber boom, fish net, "Live Box", fish ladder, flume, and debris collector. The apparatus will be operated during April, May, and June of 1965, 1966, and 1967, and will be removed prior to October 15, 1967. Navigation interests will be notified prior to placing the apparatus in operation.

The Department of Water Resources has received a Department of the Army permit for the project.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES A PERMIT TO LOCATE FISH PASSAGE FACILITIES FOR A PERIOD BEGINNING APRIL 1, 1965, AND ENDING OCTOBER 15, 1967, ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
