3. APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO INSTALL MARKER BUOYS OVER TIDE AND SUBMERCED LANDS OF SACRAMENTO RIVER, COLUSA COUNTY; DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DIVISION OF BEACHES AND PARKS - W.O. 5631, P.R.C. 3317.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 33 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DIVISION OF BEACHES AND PARKS, A FIVE-YEAR MINOR STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE PLACEMENT OF MARKER BUOYS TO DELINEATE A PUBLIC SWIMMING AREA OVER THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIPED TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER:

A PARCEL OF SUBMERCED LAND ADJACENT TO THE COLUSA-SACRAMENTO RIVER STATE PARK, ON THE RIGHT BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, COLUSA COUNTY, APPROXIMATELY 1 MILE UPSTREAM FROM COLUSA ERIDGE, BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE LOW WATER MARK ON THE RIGHT BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER WHICH BEARS N. 53° E. 3,600 FEET MORE OR LESS FROM THE INTERSECTION OF THE CENTERLINES OF 12TH AND MAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF COLUSA; THENCE FROM THE POINT OF BEGINNING PROCEEDING NORTH-EASTERLY AND NORTHERLY ALONG SAID LOW WATER MARK 600 FEET; THENCE EAST 150 FEET INTO THE SACRAMENTO RIVER; THENCE SOUTHERLY AND SOUTH-WESTERLY PARALLEL TO THE LOW WATER MARK TO AN INTERSECTION WITH A LINE WHICH REARS S. 30° E. FROM THE FOINT OF REGINNING OF THIS DESCRIPTION; THENCE N. 30° W. 150 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTENTION OF THE POINT OF BEGINNING,

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO INSTALL MARKER BUOYS OVER TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS OF SACRAMENTO RIVER, COLUSA COUNTY; DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DIVISION OF BEACHES AND PARKS - W.O. 5631.

The Division of Beaches and Parks has applied for a permit to install marker buoys on tide and submerged lands of the Sacramento River for the purpose of delineating a swimming area.

The buoys are to be installed in an area adjacent to the Colusa-Sacramento River State Recreation Area as shown on Exhibit "A". They are to be placed in the river each spring after the flood waters have receded to a normal summer level, and will be removed in the fall by the Colusa County Sheriff's Boat Patrol.

The consideration is to be the public use and benefit.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DIVISION OF BEACHES AND PARKS, A FIVE-YEAR MINOR STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR THE PLACEMENT OF MARKER BUDYS TO DELINEATE A PUBLIC SWIMMING AREA CVER THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED TIDE AND SURMERGED LANDS OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER:

A PARCEL OF SUBMERGED LAND ADJACENT TO THE COLUSA-SACRAMENTO RIVER STATE PARK, ON THE RIGHT BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, COLUSA COUNTY, APPROXIMATELY 1 MILE UPSTREAM FROM COLUSA BRIDGE, BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE LOW WATER MARK ON THE BIGHT BANK OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER WHICH BEARS N. 53° E. 3,500 FRET MORE OR LESS FROM THE INTERSECTION OF THE CENTERLINES OF 12TH AND MAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF COLUSA; THENCE FROM THE POINT OF BEGINNING PROCEEDING MORTH-EASTERLY AND MORTHERLY ALONG SAID LOW WATER MARK 600 FEET; THENCE EAST 150 FEET INTO THE SACRAMENTO RIVER; THENCE SOUTHERLY AND SOUTH-WESTERLY PARAILLEL TO THE LOW WATER MARK TO AN INTERSECTION WITH A LINE WHICH BEARS S. 30° E. FROM THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THIS DESCRIPTION; THENCE N. 30° W. 150 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 2.41 ACRES MORE OR LESS.
