5. APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF LOCATION OF SUBMERGED COMMUNICATIONS CABLE ACROSS GUALALA RIVER, SONOMA AND MENDOCINO COUNTIES; THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY - W.O. 5639, P.R.C. 3319.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 24 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7901 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND OF ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OPINION NO. 52/56, IN THE FORM PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION, APPROVING THE LOCATION OF A SUBMERGED COMMUNICATIONS CABLE ACROSS GUALALA RIVER AT GUALALA, IN SONOMA AND MENDOCINO COUNTIES, AS SHOWN ON MAP FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS DIVISION.

APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF LOCATION OF SUBMERGED COMMUNICATIONS CABLE ACROSS GUALALA RIVER, SONOMA AND MENDOCINO COUNTIES; THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY - W.O. 5639.

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, Napa, has requested approval of the location of a submerged communications cable crossing ungranted submerged land of the Gualala River at Gualala, in Sonoma and Mendocino Counties (as indicated on Exhibits "A" and "B"). The proposed crossing is 50 feet wide and approximately 536 feet long.

The Commission previously adopted an "Approval of Location Agreement Form" to be used for telephone and telegraph facilities crossing State lands, in accordance with Section 7901 of the Public Utilities Code and with Attorney General's Opinion No. 52/56.
