18. APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO CONDUCT SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL OPERATIONS; SANTA HARBARA, SAN LUIS OBISPO, MONTEREY, SANTA CRUZ, SAN MATEO, SAN FRANCISCO, MARIN, SONOMA, AND MENDOCINO COUNTIES; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC. - W.O. 5669, P.R.C. 3328.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 12 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC., A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, CON-FORMING TO ALL OPERATING CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION FOR THE CONDUCT OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION (PERATIONS, ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THY STATE LANDS COMMISSION, IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF MENDOCINO COUNTY (EXCLUDING SAN FRANCISCO BAY AND OTHER INLAND WATERS DRAINING THEREIN).

THE PERMIT IS TO BE ISSUED FOR A SIX-MONTH PERIOD FROM JUNE 28, 1965, THROUGH DECEMBER 27, 1965.

THE PERMITTEE IS TO REIMBURSE THE STATE LANDS DIVISION FOR ALL ITS INSPECTION COSTS. THE PERMIT IS TO BE EFFECTIVE ONLY AS LONG AS A CONCURRENT PERMIT BY THE FISH AND GAME COMMISSION IS IN EFFECT FOR THE SAME OPERATING AREA.

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO CONDUCT SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL OPERATIONS; SANTA BARBARA, SAN LUIS OBISPO, MONTEREY, SANTA CRUZ, SAN MATEO, SAN FRANCISCO, MARIN, SONOMA, AND MENDOCINO COUNTIES; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC. - U.O. 5669.

An application has been received from Standard Oil Company of California, Western Operations, Inc., for a permit to conduct geophysical operations during a six-month period commencing June 24, 1965, on those tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission lying between a line drawn due West from Point Conception, Santa Barbara County, and the seaward extension of the southern boundary of Humbeldt County (excluding San Francisco Bay and other inland waters draining therein).

The Boards of Supervisors of the Countles of Santa Barbara, San Huis Obispo, Monterey, Santa Cruz, San Mateo, San Francisco, Marin, Sonoma, Sud Mendocino, and the Greater Santa Cruz Chamber of Commerce, have been informed that this application is to be considered.

The statutory filing fee has been paid by the applicant.

The applicant will receive permission from the Field and Game Commission before commencing operations.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC., A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, CONFORMING TO ALL OPERATING CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION FOR THE CONDUCT OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS, ON THOSE TIL) AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION, IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF MENDOCINO COUNTY (EXCLUDING SAN FRANCISCO BAY AND OTHER INLAND WATERS DRAINING THEREIN).

THE PERMIT IS TO BE ISSUED FOR A SIX-MONTH PERIOD FROM JUNE 28, 1965, THROUGH DECEMBER 27, 1965.

THE PERMITTEE IS TO REIMBURSE THE STATE LANDS DIVISION FOR ALL ITS INSPECTION COSTS. THE PERMIT IS TO BE EFFECTIVE ONLY AS LONG AS A CONCURRENT PERMIT BY THE FISH AND GAME COMMISSION IS IN EFFECT FOR THE SAME OPERATING AREA.
