An application was received from Mr. William J. Swallow, Jr., of Yorba Linda, California, to purchase four separate parcels described as the $E_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $E_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$, $W_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $E_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$, $E_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $W_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$, and $W_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of Section 36, T. 5 N., R. 23 E., S.B.M., containing 640 acres in San Bernardino County. Prior to advertising, an offer was received from Mr. Roger C. Schafer of Thousand Oaks, California, to purchase the $E_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $W_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ and $W_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $W_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of said section.

THE PROPERTY

Location: 30 miles south of Needles and 7 miles west of Havasu Landing on Havasu Lake.

Access: A paved county road traverses all four parcels.

<u>No surface water.</u> Subsurface water is estimated to be at 400 fest.

Ferrain: Typical rolling desert - sayoth to rocky.

Creosote bush, saltbush, prickly pear, and barrel cactus; Faid Verde trees in erroyos, and filtere and annuals throughout.

Highest Use: Desert recreation cabin sites, and grazing for domestic livestock.

A staff appreisal indicates that the land is not suitable for cultivation without artificial irrigation, and establishes values as shown in the tabulation below. Mr. Swallow amended his offer in writing as to all four parcels, concurring with the appraised value in accordance with regulations. Mr. Schafer amended his offer in writing only as to the W_2^1 of W_2^1 of Section 36, which resulted in cancellation of the E_2^1 of W_2^1 from his application. The land was advertised for sale with the stipulation that bids must be in excess of the appraised values. As a result of advertising, the following bids were received:
