10. APPLICATION FOR REASSIGNMENT OF LEASE P.R.C. 2662.1, COVERING ARK SITE ON PETALUMA RIVER IN MARIN COUNTY; JOHN D. HOOPER - W.O. 5632.

After consideration of Calendar Item 2 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanancously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE THE ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE P.R.C. 2662.1, COVERING AN ARK SITE ON THE PETALUMA RIVER, MARIN COUNTY, FROM JOHN D. HOOPER AND JOAN HOOPER TO LEO J. NOLAN AND EDNA R. NOLAN. ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SAID LEASE ARE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

APPLICATION FOR REASSIGNMENT OF LEASE P.R.C. 2662.1 COVERING ARK SITE ON PETALUMA RIVER IN MARIN COUNTY; JOHN D. HOOPER - W.O. 5632.

Lease P.R.C. 2662.1, covering an ark site on the Petaluma River, was issued to Leo J. and Edna R. Nolan on October 6, 1960, for a period of ten years.

The Commission authorized the approval of an assignment of the lease on October 22, 1964, from Mr. and Mrs. Nolan to John D. and Joan Hooper. However, sale of the adjacent upland was not consummated. Now, all parties to the lease and assignment, as approved on October 22, 1964, request authority to reassign the lease to the original lessees.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO APPROVE THE ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE P.R.C. 2662.1, COVERING AN ARK SITE ON THE PETALUMA RIVER, MARIN COUNTY, FROM JOHN D. HOOPER AND JOAN HOOPER TO LEO J. NOLAN AND EDNA R. NOLAN. ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SAID LEASE ARE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
