SERVICE AGREEMENT, CHAPTER 1857, STATUTES OF 1965; COUNTY OF SAN MATEO - W.0. 5840.

Section 6359 of the Public Resources Code provides that the State Lands Commission, within two years from the effective date of the granting statute, shall survey, momment, and record a plat of any tide and submerged lands granted by the Iegislature.

Chapter 1857/65 conveys certain described tide and submerged lands to the County of San Mateo; accordingly, the State Lands Commission is required, at the cost of the grantee, to survey, monument, plat, and record a plat of the granted lands.

The work is to be performed on a contract basis, and an agreement has been drawn thot provides for the remaering of the surveyinis seivices by the State dands Division at its estimated cost of not to exceed $\$ 5,500$.

IT IS REGOMEIDED THAT THE EXCCURIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIVED TO EXECUTE A SERVICE AGRFEMENE WITH THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, CALIFORNIA, ON BEHALF OF THE STATE LARDS COMISSION AS CONHRACTOR, PROVIDING FOR SURVEYIIG AND PLATTING SERVICES TO BE REHDRRD THE COUNIY PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 1857, STATUTES OF 1965, THE PAYMEHT TO THE STATE LAIDS COMMISSION FOR SAID SERYICES TO BE THE COMMTSSION'S ACIUAL COSIS NOT TO EXCEED $\$ 5,500$.
