9. APPLICATION FOR BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT ACROSS STANISLAUS RIVER NEAR RIVERBANK, SAN JOAQUIN AND STANISLAUS COUNTIES; COUNTIES OF SAN JOAQUIN AND STANISLAUS - W.O. 5995, P.R.C. 3449.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 18 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE JOINTLY TO THE COUNTIES OF SAN JOAQUIN AND STANISLAUS A 49-YEAR EASEMENT, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE ACROSS THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED SOVEREIGN LAND:

A PARCEL OF SUBMERGED LAND 80 FEET WIDE SITUATE IN SEC. 24, T. 2 S., R. 9 E., M.D.B. & M., AND IN THE STANISLAUS RIVER, STANISLAUS AND SAN JOAQUIN COUNTIES, NORTHERLY OF THE CITY OF RIVERBANK, LYING 40 FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTERLINE:

COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 24, THENCE N. 89° 52' E. 475.95 FT. ALONG A LINE THAT COINCIDES WITH THE SOUTH LINE OF BLOCK "A" OF PALMER ADDITION TO RIVERBANK, ACCORDING TO THE MAP THEREOF RECORDED FEBRUARY 14, 1913 IN VOL. 7 OF MAPS, PAGE 26, STANISLAUS COUNTY RECORDS; TO THE CENTERLINE OF FIRST STREET; THENCE N. 0° 22' E. 220.55 FT.; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ABOUT 400 FT. ALONG THE ARC OF A TANGENT CURVE, CONCAVE WESTERLY, A DEGREE OF CURVATURE OF 1° 10' ANGLE AND A RADIUS OF 4,911.07 FT. TO A POINT ON THE LOW WATER LINE OF THE LEFT BANK OF THE STANISLAUS RIVER; SAID POINT BEING THE POINT OF BEGINNING FOR THIS DESCRIPTION; THENCE CONTINUING NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID DESCRIBED ARC, 150 FT. MORE OR LESS TO A POINT ON THE LOW WATER LINE ON THE RIGHT BANK OF SAID RIVER, CONTAINING 0.275 ACRE MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT ACROSS STANISLAUS RIVER NEAR RIVERBANK, SAN JOAQUIN AND STANISLAUS COUNTIES; COUNTIES OF SAN JOAQUIN AND STANISLAUS - W.O. 5995.

The County of Stanislaus has applied for a right-of-way easement for the construction of a bridge across an 80 x 150 foot strip of the Stanislaus River northerly of the City of Riverbank (as shown on Exhibit "A"). The easement would be issued jointly to San Joaquin and Stanislaus Counties inasmuch as the project is a joint undertaking involving sovereign land situated in both counties.

The proposed bridge alignment begins at the north end of First Street in Riverbank and terminates in San Joaquin County at its intersection with the existing Santa Fe Avenue leading to the Burneyville Ferry Bridge.

The consideration will be the public use and benefit.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE JOINTLY TO THE COUNTIES OF SAN JOAQUIN AND STANISLAUS A 49-YEAR EASEMENT, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE ACROSS THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED SOVEREIGN LAND:

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
