13. APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY ACROSS SOVEREIGN LAND IN COLORADO RIVER SOUTHWEST OF PARKER, ARIZONA; RIVERSIDE COUNTY; U. S. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, BUREAU OF RECLAMATION - W.O. 5969, P.R.C. 3450.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 34 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, BUREAU OF RECLAMATION, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, A 49-YEAR BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT OVER THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED SOVEREIGN LAND:

A STRIP OF SUBMERGED LAND 120 FEET WIDE ACROSS THE WESTERLY ONE-HALF OF THE COLORADO RIVER, RIVERSIDE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SITUATE APPROXIMATELY 11 MILES SOUTHWEST OF PARKER, ARIZONA, AND LYING 60 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED CENTERLINE:

COMMENCING AT THE CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 27, 28, 33, AND 34, T. 1 S., R. 24 E., S.B.B. & M., THENCE EAST 2,637.70 FEET, N.  $73^{\circ} 45' 23''$  E. 737.38 FEET, S.  $10^{\circ} 11' 43''$  E. 2,530.06 FEET, S.  $66^{\circ} 45' 30''$  E. 1,783.77 FEET AND N.  $89^{\circ} 56' 05''$  E. APPROXIMATELY 350 FEET TO A POINT ON THE LOW WATER MARK OF THE WESTERLY BANK OF THE COLORADO RIVER, SAID POINT BEING THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THIS DESCRIPTION; THENCE LEAVING THE LOW WATER MARK N.  $89^{\circ} 56' 05''$  E. 250 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE CALIFORNIA-ARIZONA BOUNDARY AS SAID BOUNDARY IS DESCRIBED IN THE INTERSTATE COMPACT OF 1963, DEFINING THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN THE STATES OF ARIZONA AND CALIFORNIA, CONTAINING 0.689 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY ACROSS SOVEREIGN LAND IN COLORADO RIVER SOUTHWEST OF PARKER, ARIZONA; RIVERSIDE COUNTY; U. S. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, BUREAU OF RECLAMATION - W.O. 5969.

The Bureau of Reclamation, U. S. Department of the Interior, has applied for a right-of-way easement over a 120 x 250-foot strip of sovereign land in the westerly one-half of the Colorado River, approximately 11 miles southwest of Parker, Arizona (as shown on Exhibit "A").

The easement will accommodate a timber-pile bridge with laminated-floor construction, approximately 531 feet long. Under ordinary regulated flow, it would have a minimum clearance of 18 feet and a horizontal clearance of 31 feet.

The consideration will be the public use and benefit.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, BUREAU OF RECLAMATION, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, A 49-YEAR BRIDGE RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT OVER THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED SOVEREIGN LAND:

APPROXIMATELY 350 FEET TO A POINT ON THE LOW WATER MARK OF THE WESTERLY BANK OF THE COLORADO RIVER, SAID POINT BEING THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THIS DESCRIPTION; THENCE LEAVING THE LOW WATER MARK N. 89° 56' 05" E. 250 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE CALIFORNIA-ARIZONA BOUNDARY AS SAID BOUNDARY IS DESCRIBED IN THE INTERSTATE COMPACT OF 1963, DEFINING THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN THE STATES OF ARIZONA AND CALIFORNIA, CONTAINING 0.689 ACRE MORE OR LESS.
