

## 40. PROPOSED OIL AND GAS LEASE, VENTURA COUNTY - W.O. 6070 (PARCEL 34).

After consideration of Calendar Item 44 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO OFFER A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN VENTURA COUNTY FOR OIL AND GAS LEASE, PURSUANT TO DIVISION 6 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.

THE LEASE AWARD IS TO BE MADE TO THE QUALIFIED BIDDER OFFERING THE HIGHEST CASH-BONUS PAYMENT IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF AN OIL AND GAS LEASE.

THE BID-LEASE FORM TO BE USED FOR THE PARCEL SHALL BE THE FORM APPROVED AND ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION ON NOVEMBER 15, 1960, AND AMENDED NOVEMBER 6, 1963. THE LEASE RENTAL IS TO BE \$1.00 PER ACRE PER YEAR.

THE AREA PROPOSED TO BE OFFERED, DESIGNATED AS W.O. 6070 (PARCEL 34), IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

W.O. 6070 (PARCEL 34)

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL IN VENTURA COUNTY, SITUATE NEAR POINT MIGU, AND BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTH-SOUTH CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,703,200 WITH THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL, THENCE SOUTH ALONG THE AFOREMENTIONED GRID LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH AN ENVELOPE LINE EVERY POINT WHICH IS AT A DISTANCE OF 3 GEOGRAPHICAL MILES FROM THE NEAREST POINT ON THE LINE OF ORDINARY LOW WATER OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL OR AT A DISTANCE OF 3 GEOGRAPHICAL MILES FROM THE PRESENTLY EXISTING OUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS WITHIN OR IN THE VICINITY OF THE LEASEHOLD AREA, WHICHEVER SHALL BE FURTHER SEAWARD; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID ENVELOPE LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A NORTH-SOUTH CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,691,600; THENCE NORTH ALONG THE GRID LINE TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE ABOVE-MENTIONED MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING CONTAINING 5,305 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

FOR PURPOSES OF THIS DESCRIPTION THE TERMS "LINE OF ORDINARY LOW WATER" AND "GEOGRAPHICAL MILES" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS SAID TERMS HAVE AS USED IN THE SUBMERGED LANDS ACT OF 1953 (67 STAT. 29), AND THE TERM "OUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS" SHALL MEAN THE OUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS WHICH ARE REGARDED AS FORMING A PART OF THE ROAD WITHIN THE MEANING OF ARTICLE 8 ON THE CONVENTION OF THE TERRITORIAL SEA AND THE CONTIGUOUS ZONE ADOPTED APRIL 27, 1958 (U.N. DOC. A/CONF. 13/L.52).

PROPOSED OIL AND GAS LEASE, VENTURA COUNTY - W.O. 6070 (PARCEL 34).

Pursuant to the sequential bidding procedure approved by the State Lands Commission on November 15, 1960, for oil and gas lease offers of tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the Commission, it has been determined by the staff that the offshore area designated as W.O. 6070 (Parcel 34), southwesterly of Point Mugu in Ventura County, should be considered for lease offer.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO OFFER A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN VENTURA COUNTY FOR OIL AND GAS LEASE, PURSUANT TO DIVISION 6 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.

THE LEASE AWARD IS TO BE MADE TO THE QUALIFIED BIDDER OFFERING THE HIGHEST CASH-BONUS PAYMENT IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF AN OIL AND GAS LEASE.

THE BID-LEASE FORM TO BE USED FOR THE PARCEL SHALL BE THE FORM APPROVED AND ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION ON NOVEMBER 15, 1960, AND AMENDED NOVEMBER 6, 1963. THE LEASE RENTAL IS TO BE \$1.00 PER ACRE PER YEAR.

W.O. 6070 (PARCEL 34)

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL IN VENTURA COUNTY, SITUATE NEAR POINT MUGU, AND BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTH-SOUTH CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,703,200 WITH THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL, THENCE SOUTH ALONG THE AFOREMENTIONED GRID LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH AN ENVELOPE LINE EVERY POINT WHICH IS AT A DISTANCE OF 3 GEOGRAPHICAL MILES FROM THE NEAREST POINT ON THE LINE OF ORDINARY LOW WATER OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL OR AT A DISTANCE OF 3 GEOGRAPHICAL MILES FROM THE PRESENTLY EXISTING CUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS WITHIN OR IN THE VICINITY OF THE LEASEHOLD AREA, WHICHEVER SHALL BE FURTHER SEAWARD; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID ENVELOPE LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A NORTH-SOUTH CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,691,600; THENCE NORTH ALONG THE GRID LINE TO AN INTERSECTION WITH THE ABOVEMENTIONED MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING CONTAINING 5,305 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

FOR PURPOSES OF THIS DESCRIPTION THE TERMS "LINE OF ORDINARY LOW WATER" AND "GEOGRAPHICAL MILES" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS SAID TERMS HAVE AS USED IN THE SUBMERGED LANDS ACT OF 1953 (67 STAT. 29), AND THE TERM "OUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS" SHALL MEAN THE OUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS WHICH ARE REGARDED AS FORMING A PART OF THE COAST WITHIN THE MEANING OF ARTICLE 8 ON THE CONVENTION OF THE TERRITORIAL SEA AND THE CONTIGUOUS ZONE ADOPTED APRIL 27, 1958 (U.N. DOC. A/CONF. 13/L.52).
