APPLICATION FOR EASEMENT TO COVER AN EXISTING OVERHEAD TRANSMISSION LINE CROSSING ALAMEDA CREEK, NEAR ALVARADO, IN ALAMEDA COUNTY; PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY - W.O. 3107.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company has applied for an overhead transmissionline easement across Alameda Creek, one mile west of Alvarado, in Alameda County (as shown on Exhibit "A").

The land is part of an exchange of lands with Leslie Salt Co., which has consummated on January 10, 1963, and the transmission line was installed during the period of negotiations.

The easement area consists of two parcels, as follows:

Parcel 1 encompasses 0.392 acre of land acquired by the State in exchange with Leslie Salt Co., and is encumbered by a perpetual easement granted to the applicant prior to acceptance by the State.

<u>Parcel 2</u> encompasses 0.273 acre of land contiguous to the above land and unencumbered, being part of the original bed of Alameda Creek.

A staff appreisal indicates a total rental of \$300.90 for Parcel 2 during a 15-year lease period. The agreement will provide for three 10-year renewal options.
