

33. PROPOSED OIL AND GAS LEASES, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY - W.O. 6075 (PARCEL 35), W.O. 6080 (PARCEL 36); W.O. 6085 (PARCEL 37); W.O. 6090 (PARCEL 38); W.O. 6095 (PARCEL 39); W.O. 6100 (PARCEL 40).

After consideration of Calendar Items 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, and 30 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried,

A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO OFFER SIX PARCELS OF SUBMERGED LAND IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY FOR OIL AND GAS LEASE PURSUANT TO DIVISION 6 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, WITH THE FIRST PARCEL TO BE OFFERED EITHER THE LATTER PART OF MAY OR APPROXIMATELY JUNE 1, 1966, WHICHEVER DAY IS APPROPRIATE, AND THE REST OF THE PARCELS TO BE OFFERED SEQUENTIALLY WITH A DAY INTERVENING BETWEEN BID OPENINGS.

THE LEASE AWARDS ARE TO BE MADE TO THE QUALIFIED BIDDERS OFFERING THE HIGHEST CASH-BONUS PAYMENTS IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE OIL AND GAS LEASES. THE BYO-LEASE FORM TO BE USED SHALL BE THE FORM APPROVED AND ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION ON NOVEMBER 15, 1960, AND AMENDED NOVEMBER 6, 1963. THE LEASE RENTAL IS TO BE \$1.00 PER ACRE PER YEAR.

THE AREAS PROPOSED TO BE OFFERED ARE DESIGNATED AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

W.O. 6075 (PARCEL 35)

BOUNDED ON THE EAST BY A NORTH-SOUTH GRID LINE HAVING A CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 X COORDINATE OF 1,310,420; SAID GRID LINE IS A SOUTHERLY EXTENSION OF THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF AFOREMENTIONED P.R.C. 2206.1; AND BOUNDED ON THE WEST BY A NORTH-SOUTH GRID LINE HAVING A CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 X COORDINATE OF 1,299,860; SAID GRID LINE IS A SOUTHERLY EXTENSION OF THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF ABOVEMENTIONED P.R.C. 2206.1; CONTAINING 780 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

BOUNDED ON THE EAST BY A NORTH-SOUTH GRID LINE HAVING A CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 X COORDINATE OF 1,341,280; SAID GRID LINE IS A SOUTHERLY EXTENSION OF THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF AFOREMENTIONED P.R.C. 2199.1; AND BOUNDED ON THE WEST BY A NORTH-SOUTH GRID LINE HAVING A CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 X COORDINATE OF 1,330,720; SAID GRID LINE IS A SOUTHERLY EXTENSION OF THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF ABOVEMENTIONED P.R.C. 2199.1; CONTAINING 600 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

PROPOSED OIL AND GAS LEASE, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY - W.O. 6075 (PARCEL 35).

Pursuant to bidding procedures approved by the State Lands Commission on November 15, 1960, for oil and gas lease offers of tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the Commission, it has been determined by the staff that the offshore area designated as W.O. 6075 (Parcel 35), lying south of Oil and Gas Lease P.R.C. 2206 in the Santa Barbara Channel and southwest of Gaviota in Santa Barbara County, should be considered for lease offer.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO OFFER A PARCEL OF SUBMERGED LAND IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY FOR OIL AND GAS LEASE PURSUANT TO DIVISION 6 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.

THE LEASE AWARD IS TO BE MADE TO THE QUALIFIED BIDDER OFFERING THE HIGHEST CASH-BONUS PAYMENT IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE OIL AND GAS LEASE. THE BID-LEASE FORM TO BE USED FOR THE PARCEL SHALL BE THE FORM APPROVED AND ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION ON NOVEMBER 15, 1960, AND AMENDED NOVEMBER 6, 1963. THE LEASE RENTAL IS TO BE \$1.00 PER ACRE PER YEAR.

BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTH-SOUTH CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,279,560 WITH A LINE PARALLEL TO THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL AND SEAWARD THEREFROM 3 STATUTE MILES (SAID GRID LINE BEING THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF P.R.C. 2207); THENCE SOUTH ALONG SAID NORTH-SOUTH GRID LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH AN ENVELOPE LINE EVERY POINT WHICH IS AT A DISTANCE OF 3 GEOGRAPHICAL MILES FROM THE NEAREST POINT ON THE LINE OF ORDINARY LOW WATER OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL OR AT A DISTANCE OF 3 GEOGRAPHICAL MILES FROM THE PRESENTLY EXISTING OUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS IF ANY WITHIN OR IN THE VICINITY OF THE LEASEHOLD AREA, WHICHEVER SHALL BE FURTHER SEAWARD; THENCE WESTERLY ALONG SAID ENVELOPE LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A NORTH-SOUTH CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,255,500 (SAID GRID LINE IS THE SOUTHERLY EXTENSION OF THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF P.R.C. 2879); THENCE NORTH ALONG SAID GRID LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A LINE PARALLEL TO THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL AND SEAWARD THEREFROM 3

NAUTICAL MILES (SAID LINE BEING THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2879); THENCE EASTERLY ALONG THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF SAID LEASE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A NORTH-SOUTH CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,269,000; THENCE NORTH ALONG SAID NORTH-SOUTH GRID LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A LINE PARALLEL TO THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL AND SEAWARD THEREFROM 3 STATUTE MILES (SAID LINE BEING THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2207); THENCE EASTERLY ALONG THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF SAID LEASE TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; CONTAINING 1,340 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

FOR PURPOSES OF THIS DESCRIPTION THE TERMS "LINE OF ORDINARY LOW WATER" AND "GEOGRAPHICAL MILES" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS SAID TERMS HAVE AS USED IN THE SUBMERGED LANDS ACT OF 1953 (67 STAT. 29), AND THE TERM "OUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS" SHALL MEAN THE OUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS WHICH ARE REGARDED AS FORMING A PART OF THE COAST WITHIN THE MEANING OF ARTICLE 8 ON THE CONVENTION OF THE TERRITORIAL SEA AND THE CONTIGUOUS ZONE ADOPTED APRIL 27, 1958 (U.N. DOC. A/CONF. 13/L.52).
