34. CONCURRENCES IN RIGHTS OF ENTRY GRANTED BY CITY OF LONG BEACH, PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, ALAMITOS BAY AREA, LONG BEACH, TO STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS - W.O. 2716.721.

After consideration of Calendar Item 36 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN THE RIGHTS OF ENTRY ATTACHED TO CITY OF LONG BEACH RESOLUTIONS NO. C-19620 AND NO. C-19621, ENTITLED RESPECTIVELY, " A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A RIGHT OF ENTRY TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A PUBLIC BRIDGE AND HIGHWAY, VICINITY OF LOS CERRITOS CHANNEL", AND " A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A RIGHT OF ENTRY TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A PUBLIC BRIDGE AND HIGHWAY, VICINITY OF SAN GABRIEL RIVER", INDICATING THE COMMISSION'S CONCURRENCE IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH'S ISSUANCE OF SAID RIGHTS OF ENTRY IN THE ALAMITOS BAY AREA OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH; SAID RIGHTS OF ENTRY TO TERMINATE NO LATER THAN 20 YEARS FROM APRIL 12, 1966.

The Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, has requested rights of entry over tide and submerged lands granted to the City of Long Beach, in trust, for the purpose of allowing the widening of Pacific Coast Highway in the Alamitos Bay Area of Long Beach. The City on April 12, 1966, granted the requested rights of entry as to such lands within the areas of permits (as shown on maps attached to Exhibits 1 and 2), as may constitute tide and submerged or proprietary lands of the City. Determination of the precise boundaries of the tide and submerged lands is the subject of current study by the Commission's staff and the Attorney General's Office. Consequently, the City has requested the concurrence of the State Lands Commission in the issuance of the rights of entry to insure that the study is not adversely affected by the City's action.

The reason for the issuance of the rights of entry is to allow the immediate widening of the Pacific Coast Highway without waiting for the precise determination of the boundaries. A review of the rights of entry submitted by the City indicates that they are broadly worded so as to not adversely affect the current boundary study.

The maximum term of each of the rights of entry is 20 years.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO SIGN THE RIGHTS OF ENTRY ATTACHED TO CITY OF LONG BEACH RESOLUTIONS NO. C-19620 AND NO. C-19621, ENTITLED RESPECTIVELY, "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A RIGHT OF ENTRY TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A PUBLIC BRIDGE AND HIGHWAY, VICINITY OF LOS CERRITOS CHANNEL", AND "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A RIGHT OF ENTRY TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A PUBLIC BRIDGE AND HIGHWAY, VICINITY OF SAN GABRIEL RIVER", INDICATING THE COMMISSION'S CONCURRENCE IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH'S ISSUANCE OF SAID RIGHTS OF ENTRY IN THE ALAMITOS BAY AREA OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH; SAID RIGHTS OF ENTRY TO TERMINATE NO LATER THAN 20 YEARS FROM APRIL 20, 1966.
