APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF ASSIGNMENT, LEASE P.R.C. 389.1, TIDE AND SUBMERCED LAND, SACRAMENTO RIVER, YOLO COUNTY; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W.O. 6168.

Lease P.R.C. 389.1, covering 0.29 acre of tide and submerged land of the Sacramento River near Clarksburg, Yolo County (see Exhibit "A"), was issued to Standard Oil Company of California on December 10, 1948, for a term of 15 years, and later was renewed for an additional period of 10 years. The leased area is used for a loading dock with protective dolphins. The lease provides for annual rental of \$150, and a continuing surety bond for \$1600.

Standard Oil Company of California has sold the adjacent upland to Delta Dehydrating Corporation and now requests consent of the State to the assignment of the lease to the new upland owner, as provided for in Paragraph 5 of the lease agreement.
