APPLICATION FOR RECREATIONAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, SUBMERGED LAND IN LAKE TAHOE, PLACER COUNTY; ATTILIO AND PANOLA LOMBARDI - W.O. 6227.

Mr. and Mrs. Attilio Lombardi, owners of the adjacent upland, have applied for a recreational minor-structure permit to maintain an existing pier and boathouse on 0.023 acre of sovereign land in Lake Tahoe at Carnelian Bay, Placer County (shown on Exhibit "A").

The permit will replace a rent-free recreational pier permit which expires September 12, 1966. The applicants do not qualify for a rent-free permit under current law.

A fee of \$25 will be charged for five years commencing September 13, 1966.
