People vs. City of Long Beach, et al.
Los Angeles County Superior Court
(Long Beach Boundary Determination, Chapter 2000/57)

H.O. 2716

An apparent agreement in principle has been reached as to the terms of the proposed Decree to be entered pursuant to Ch. 138/1964, 1st E.S., and it is hoped that a Decree will be actually prepared and submitted to the Court within four to six weeks.

2. Case No. 55800
People vs. Monterey Sand Co., et al.
Monterey County Superior Court

w.o. 1839.16

(Action for declaratory relief, damages for trespass, quiet 'le, accounting, and injunction. It is alleged that the materey Sand Company is treapassing upon tide and submerged lands owned by the State, and is removing valuable sand deposits from said lands without paying any royalty to the State.)

Answers to the State's Interrogatories have been filed by the Defendant, and the State has moved for an Order Requiring Further Answers to 65 of the Interrogatories. Hearing is set on the Motion for November 14, 1966.

3. Case No. 30417 City of Morro Bay vs. County of San Luis Obispo and State of California San Luis Obispo County Superior Court

11.0. 503.461

(By Chapter 1076, Stats. of 1947, certain tide and submerged lands in the vicinity of Morro Bay were granted to the County of San Luis Obispo. On July 17, 1964, the City of Morro Bay was incorporated so as to include the area of the granted tidelands. The purpose of the present action is to determine whether or not the City of Morro Bay acquired title to these tide and submerged lands as successor to the County and whether the City must take immediate title to such lands or may postpone taking title to some future date.)

## INFORMATIVE CALENDAR ITEM 30. (CONTD.)

The scheduled executive session of a Subcommittee of the Joint Legislative Tidelands Committee and representatives of the City, the County, and the State, in an attempt to work out a settlement of differences, was held on October 21, 1966, and negotiations for set lement are pending.

4. Case No. 107490
People vs. Pacific Fluorite Company, et al.
San Bernardino County Superior Court

W.O. 2875.15

(Action (1) to eject Pacific Fluorite Co. of California (a California corporation) from Section 16, T. 17 N., R. 13 E., S.B.M., San Bernardino County; and (2) to quiet the State's title; and (3) to obtain an accounting for rents and profits -- mineral trespass.)

No change; i.e., The Trial Briefs have been submitted by all parties, including the State, and the question as to the State's title is presently under submission. If the State's title is upheld, further proceedings may be necessary to determine the question of damages.

Town of Emeryville vs. The State of California
Sacramento County Superior Court

(Action in declaratory relief to determine whether a proposed plan of development is in conformity with the trust under which tide and submerged lands were granted to the Town of Emeryville by the State of California.)

(Suit to quiet title to land adjacent to the Sacramento River.)
