COMPLETION OF EXPENDITURE OF TIDELAND OIL REVENUES BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SUBMARINE PIPELINE CROSSING AT LOS CERRITOS CHANNEL - L.B.W.O. 10,142.

On May 25, 1961 (Minute Item 13, page 6966), the Commission, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 29, Statutes of 1956, 1st E.S., gave prior approval to the costs proposed to be expended by the City of Long Beach from its share or tideland oil revenues in an amount not more than \$20,000 nor more than 19.23 per cent of the cost of construction (exclusive of the costs of removal of the existing pipeline trestle) of a submarine pipeline crossing of the Los Cerritos Channel; subject to the condition that the City has no intention of replacing the vehicular bridge formerly located across Los Cerritos Channel on Park Boulevard at the Marine Stadium, which bridge was removed by City forces in December 1960; and also subject to the condition that the work conform to the plans and background material previously submitted to the Commission by the City.

The conditions placed upon the approval have been met. Staff audit indicates a total trust expenditure of \$9,740.10, which is less than \$20,000, and is equal to 19.23 per cent of the costs of the accomplished work. Inspection by staff engineers verifies that the completed work conforms essentially to the proposals submitted by the City of Long Beach.
