## EXHIBIT "A"

A strip of tide and submerged land 25 feet wide across the bed of the Napa River situate approximately 4 miles southerly of the City of Napa, Napa County; lying 12-1/2 feet on each side of the following-described centerline:

Commencing at a brass cap monument designated "Suscol Creek 1948" which has California Zone 2 coordinate values of X = 1,918,186.37, Y = 208,869.35 and is shown on sheet 8 of 13 of a series of maps of a "Survey of the Ordinary High Water Mark along the Napa River" said maps were filed September 14, 1954 under Serial No. S. 1109 Records of Napa County; thence S. 8° 46' 13" E., 63.93 feet, S. 11° 51' 47" W. 220.30 feet and N. 74° 59' 13" W. 9.90 feet more or less to a point on the Ordinary High Water Mark of the easterly bank of the Napa River, said point being the true point of beginning of this description; thence N. 74° 59' 13" W. 453.32 feet more or less to the Ordinary High Water Mark on the westerly bank of the Napa River; containing 0.260 acre more or less.

The bearings and distances used in the above description are based on the California coordinate system Zone 2.

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
