EXHIBIT "A"

All that certain real property situate in the County of El Dorado, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

Lot 1 of the Northwest quarter of Section 17, Township 14 North Range 17 East, M.D.B. & M.

SAVING AND EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion thereof lying Southwesterly of the Northeast boundary of State Highway 89.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM that portion thereof which is included within the boundaries of a 7.304 acre parcel described in the deed from Frank J. Pomin and wife, to Richard Kirman, dated October 10, 1913, recorded in Book 81 of Deeds, at Page 107, Records of El Dorado County, and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 17, Township 14 North, Range 17 East, M.D.B. & M., thence running along the quarter Section line West 500 feet; thence North $21^{\circ} 19' 40''$ East 1278.14 feet to a stake on the shore of Lake Tahoe; thence along the shore of Lake Tahoe South $61^{\circ} 23'$ East 40 feet to meander post; from which a yellow pine, 18 inches in diameter, bears North $85^{\circ} 50'$ West 20 feet and a fir 10 inches in diameter bears South $22^{\circ} 30'$ East 29.7 feet, thence along the East line of said Lot 1, South 1171.5 feet to the place of beginning and constituting a fractional part of Lot 1 of Section 17, Township 14 North, Range 17 East, M.D.B. & M.
