34. EXTENSION OF TERM, GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT P.R.C. 2823.1; SAN LUIS OBISPO SOUTH THROUGH SAN DIEGO COUNTY; SIGNAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY.

After consideration of Calendar Item 8 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO SIGNAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT P.R.C. 2823.1 FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 1967, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1967, ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION LYING IN THE AREA BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF AND A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA. ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT ARE TO REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TERM OF GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT P.R.C. 2823.1; SAN LUIS OBISPO, SANTA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE, AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; SIGNAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY.

An application has been received from Signal Oil and Gas Company for an extension of the term of Geological Survey Permit P.P.C. 2823.1 for the period July 1, 1967, through December 31, 1967, in order to continue core-drilling operations. The present permit will expire on June 30, 1967.
