36. EXTENSION OF TERM, GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT P.R.C. 3706.1; SANTA BARBARA NORTH THROUGH MENDOCINO COUNTIES; CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY.

After consideration of Calendar Item 50 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY AN EXTENSION OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT P.R.C. 3706.1 FOR THE PERIOD JULY 24, 1967, THROUGH JANUARY 23, 1968, ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF MENDOCINO COUNTY, EXCLUDING SAN FRANCISCO BAY AND OTHER INLAND WATERS DRAINING THEREIN. ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT ARE TO REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TERM OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT P.R.C. 3706.1; SANTA BARBARA, SAN LUIS OBISPO, MONTEREY, SANTA CRUZ, SAN MATEO, SAN FRANCISCO, MARIN, SONOMA, AND MENDOCINO COUNTIES; CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY.

An application has been received from Continental Oil Company for an extension of the term of Geophysical Exploration Permit P.R.C. 3706.1 for the period July 24, 1967, through January 23, 1968, in order to continue geophysical exploration operations. The present permit will expire on July 23, 1967.
