

38. EXTENSION OF TERM, GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT P.R.C. 2607.1; MENDOCINO SOUTH THROUGH SANTA BARBARA COUNTY; SHELL OIL COMPANY.

After consideration of Calendar Item 5 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO SHELL OIL COMPANY AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT P.R.C. 2607.1 FOR THE PERIOD JULY 16, 1967, THROUGH JANUARY 15, 1968, ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION, IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF MENDOCINO COUNTY (EXCLUDING SAN FRANCISCO BAY AND OTHER INLAND WATERS DRAINING THEREIN). ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT ARE TO REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TERM OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT P.R.C. 2607.1; MENDOCINO, SONOMA, MARIN, SAN FRANCISCO, SAN MATEO, SANTA CRUZ, MONTEREY, SAN LUIS OBISPO, AND SANTA BARBARA COUNTIES; SHELL OIL COMPANY.

An application has been received from Shell Oil Company for an extension of the term of Geophysical Exploration Permit P.R.C. 2607.1 from July 16, 1967, through January 15, 1968, in order to continue geophysical exploration operations. The present permit will expire on July 15, 1967.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO SHELL OIL COMPANY AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT P.R.C. 2607.1 FOR THE PERIOD JULY 16, 1967, THROUGH JANUARY 15, 1968, ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION, IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF MENDOCINO COUNTY (EXCLUDING SAN FRANCISCO BAY AND OTHER INLAND WATERS DRAINING THEREIN).
