9. NON-COMMERCIAL USE PERMIT, LOS PADRES MINE, SEISMIC DETECTION STATION, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY; UNITED STATES ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION - W.O. 6577, P.R.C. 3800.2.

After consideration of Calendar Item 27 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE UNITED STATES ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION A FIVE-YEAR NON-COMMERCIAL USE PERMIT, IN CONSIDERATION OF AN ANNUAL RENTAL OF \$50, FOR A SEISMIC DETECTION STATION AND ANCILLARY FACILITIES, ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, WITH LESSEE'S RIGHT TO RENEW FOR ONE ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS UPON SUCH REASONABLE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE STATE MIGHT IMPOSE.

NON-COMMERCIAL USE PERMIT

APPLICANT: United States Atomic Energy Commission

LOCATION: Los Padres Mine, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T. 4 N., R. 5 E., S.B.M.,
San Bernardino County

PROPOSED USE: Related to National Defense - A seismic detection station
consisting of an electrical console with ancillary facilities
and a data circuit from the site to the Lawrence Radiation
Laboratory

TERMS: Initial period: 5 years, from July 27, 1967
Renewal option: 1 additional period of 5 years

CONSIDERATION: \$50 per annum

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
6% of appraised value of land

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
A remote area approximately 55 miles southeast of Victorville.
The mine will provide built-in protection for highly sensitive
equipment. Because of the urgency of the project, the appli-
cant has agreed to a permit subject to existing mining claims.

EXHIBIT "A"

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Section 36, T. 4 N., R. 5 E., S.B.B. & M., thence Westerly along the South Line of said Section 36 a distance of 2000 feet more or less to a point; thence Northerly and parallel to the East Line of Section 36, a distance of 1850 feet more or less, to a point, said point being the True Point of Beginning; thence continuing Northerly along the aforementioned line a distance of 1250 feet to a point on the North Line of said Section 36; thence Westerly and parallel to the South Line of Section 36, a distance of 1000 feet more or less to a point, being the Northwest Corner of said Section 36, thence Southerly and parallel to the East Line of Section 36, a distance of 1250 feet more or less to a point, thence Easterly and parallel to the South Line of Section 36, a distance of 1000 feet more or less to the True Point of Beginning, containing 28.7 acres, more or less.
