

18. PERMIT TO CONDUCT SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS; MENDOCINO SOUTH THROUGH SAN DIEGO COUNTY; PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY - W.O. 6639, P.R.C. 3804.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 13 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, CONFORMING TO ALL OPERATING CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION FOR THE CONDUCT OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS, ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF MENDOCINO COUNTY AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING:

1. SAN FRANCISCO BAY AND OTHER INLAND WATERS DRAINING THEREIN;
2. LANDS INCLUDED IN SECTION 6871.2(b) OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE;
3. LANDS LYING ADJACENT TO THE MAINLAND BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE NORTH-WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF.

THE PERMIT IS TO BE ISSUED FOR A SIX-MONTH PERIOD FROM JULY 27, 1967, THROUGH JANUARY 26, 1968, AND IS TO SUPERSEDE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT P.R.C. 3181.1.

THE PERMITTEE IS TO REIMBURSE THE STATE LANDS DIVISION FOR ALL OF ITS INSPECTION COSTS. THE PERMIT IS TO BE EFFECTIVE ONLY AS LONG AS A CONCURRENT PERMIT BY THE FISH AND GAME COMMISSION IS IN EFFECT FOR THE SAME OPERATING AREA.

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO CONDUCT SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS; MENDOCINO, SONOMA, MARIN, SAN FRANCISCO, SAN MATEO, SANTA CRUZ, MONTEREY, SAN LUIS OBISPO, SANTA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE, AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY - W.O. 6639.

An application has been received from Phillips Petroleum Company for a permit to conduct submarine geophysical exploration operations in the area lying between the northern boundary of Mendocino County and the seaward extension thereof, and the southern boundary of the State of California.

Phillips Petroleum Company has been conducting seismic operations under Geophysical Exploration Permit P.R.C. 3181.1, covering the tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission in the area lying between a line drawn due West from Point Conception, Santa Barbara County, and the southern boundary of the State of California. This permit, issued on August 18, 1964, expires on August 17, 1967.

The Boards of Supervisors of the counties of Mendocino, Sonoma, Marin, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Cruz, Monterey and San Luis Obispo, and the Greater Santa Cruz Chamber of Commerce have been informed that this application is to be considered. The Boards of Supervisors of the counties covered by Geophysical Permit P.R.C. 3181.1 have been previously notified.

The statutory filing fee has been paid by the applicant.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT, CONFORMING TO ALL OPERATING CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION FOR THE CONDUCT OF GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION OPERATIONS, ON THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION IN THE AREA LYING BETWEEN THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF MENDOCINO COUNTY AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING:

1. SAN FRANCISCO BAY AND OTHER INLAND WATERS DRAINING THEREIN;
2. LANDS INCLUDED IN SECTION 6871.2(b) OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE;
3. LANDS LYING ADJACENT TO THE MAINLAND BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE NORTH-WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF.

THE PERMIT IS TO BE ISSUED FOR A SIX-MONTH PERIOD FROM JULY 27, 1967, THROUGH JANUARY 26, 1968, AND IS TO SUPERSEDE GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT P.R.C. 3181.1.

THE PERMITTEE IS TO REIMBURSE THE STATE LANDS DIVISION FOR ALL OF ITS INSPECTION COSTS. THE PERMIT IS TO BE EFFECTIVE ONLY AS LONG AS A CONCURRENT PERMIT BY THE FISH AND GAME COMMISSION IS IN EFFECT FOR THE SAME OPERATING AREA.
