3. DREDGING PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, TORRANCE BEACH, LOS ANGELES COUNTY; COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES - W.O. 6632, P.R.C. 3810.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 14 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 600,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL, WITHOUT PAYMENT OF ROYALTY, FROM AN AREA OF STATE-OWNED TIDELANDS OFFSHORE FROM THE CITY OF TORRANCE, AND TO DEPOSIT 400,000 CUBIC YARDS OF THE MATERIAL ON STATE TIDELANDS ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF TORRANCE AND 200,000 UPON GRANTED TIDELANDS ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH. THE AREA TO BE DREDGED IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

THAT PORTION OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, WITHIN THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED BOUNDARIES:

COMMENCING AT THE EASTERLY TERMINUS OF THAT CERTAIN COURSE HAVING A BEARING AND LENGTH OF NORTH 87° 51' 12" WEST 174.77 FEET IN THE NORTHERLY BOUNDARY OF LOT 2, BLOCK C, TRACT NO. 10303, AS SHOWN ON MAP RECORDED IN BOOK 152, PAGES 34, 35 AND 36, OF MAPS, IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF SAID COUNTY; THENCE NORTH 87° 51' 12" WEST ALONG SAID CERTAIN COURSE AND ITS WESTERLY PROLONGATION A DISTANCE OF 1708.00 FEET TO THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE SOUTH 14° 43' 48" WEST 3980 FEET; THENCE NORTH 81° 16' 12" WEST 1080.00 FEET; THENCE NORTH 18° 43' 48" EAST TO SAID WESTERLY PROLONGATION; THENCE SOUTH 87° 51' 12" EAST ALONG SAID WESTERLY PROLONGATION TO SAID TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 85 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT IS THE PUBLIC BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR DREDGING PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, TORRANCE BEACH, LOS ANGELES COUNTY; COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES - W.O. 6632.

An application has been received from the County of Los Angeles for a permit to dredge an area of State-owned tideland at a depth greater than -35 feet below the mean high tide line offshore from the City of Torrance. Approximately 600,000 cubic yards of material are to be dredged from the proposed dredge area, 400,000 cubic yards of which will be deposited upon tideland adjacent to the beach north-easterly from the dredge area (see Exhibit "A"). The remainder (200,000 cubic yards) will be disposed of on an area of granted tidelands under the jurisdiction of the City of Redondo Beach.

According to the applicant, the project will restore and protect a badly needed recreation beach serving the citizens of California, and has been recommended by engineering and oceanographic experts from the County Engineer Department, the State Department of Water Resources, and the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers. It has been approved by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, the California State Legislature, and the Congress of the United States. Section 6303 of the Public Resources Code provides that when an applicant has a permit from the Federal Government, the Commission may grant the privilege of depositing material upon, or removing or extracting material from, tide or submerged lands owned by the State for the improvement of navigation or reclamation upon such terms and conditions and for such consideration as will be for the best interests of the State.

The applicant has been issued a letter of permission by the U. S. Corps of Engineers approving the general design for beach protection and widening from Redondo Beach to Malaga Cove, subject to revision.

The Department of Water Resources has reported that it is aware of the planned construction of the shore protection project and has no objection to the granting of the permit. The Department of Parks and Recreation has stated that issuance of the permit would have no effect upon any project or program of that department. The Department of Fish and Game has stated that although a temporary dislocation of marine life may result from such a project, the effect is temporary, and that it therefore has no objection to issuance of the permit.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 600,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL, WITHOUT PAYMENT OF ROYALTY, FROM AN AREA OF STATE-OWNED TIDELANDS OFFSHORE FROM THE CITY OF TORRANCE, AND TO DEPOSIT 400,000 CUBIC YARDS OF THE MATERIAL ON STATE TIDELANDS ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF TORRANCE AND 200,000 UPON GRANTED TIDELANDS ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH. PROLONGATION A DISTANCE OF 1708.00 FEET TO THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;
THENCE SOUTH $14^{\circ} 43' 48''$ WEST 3980 FEET; THENCE NORTH $81^{\circ} 16' 12''$ WEST
1080.00 FEET; THENCE NORTH $18^{\circ} 43' 48''$ EAST TO SAID WESTERLY PROLONGATION;
