2. AMENDMENT TO LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT P.R.C. 3777.9, AMERICAN RIVER, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES - W.O. 6319.

After consideration of Calendar Item 27 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT P.R.C. 3777.9 TO PROVIDE THAT THE PROPOSED USE SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:
"TO COMPLEMENT DEVELOPMENT OF THE NEW CALIFORNIA STATE EXPOSITION AND FAIR, INCLUDING GOLF COURSES, AQUATIC PARK, RIVER BANK PROTECTION, BRIDLE PATHS, AND HIKING TRAILS."

APPLICANT: State of California, Department of General Services

LOCATION: Sovereign land of American River, City of Sacramento,
Sacramento County

PROPOSED USE: To complement development of the new California State
Exposition and Fair, including golf courses, aquatic park,
River-bank protection, bridle paths, and hiking trails.

TERMS: Initial period: 49 years, from June 22, 1967

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit. No charge.

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:
U.S.A. Corps of Engineers navigational permit issued.
Applicant is owner of upland.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

The State Lands Commission approved the issuance of Life-of-Structure Permit P.R.C. 3777.9 to the Department of General Services on June 22, 1967. The Department requests that the proposed use under the original permit be expanded to include golf courses and an aquatic park.
