4. RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT, PETALUMA CREEK, MARIN COUNTY; SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 6 OF MARIN COUNTY - W.O. N0002, P.R.C. 3861.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 36 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT

APPLICANT: Sanitary District No. 6 of Marin County

LOCATION: A 2.64-acre strip of tide and submerged land in Petaluma Creek northerly of Novato, Marin County

PROPOSED USE: The installation of a sewage effluent outfall channel

TERM: 49 years, from January 1, 1968

CONSIDERATION: No charge. (The public health and benefit)

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:

U.S.A. Corps of Engineers permit not required.

The Water Quality Control Board has issued its requirements covering the facility.

Applicant is owner of upland.

Lessee: Sanitary District No. 6 - Marin County
Bahia Treatment Plant Effluent Channel

A parcel of tide and submerged land in Petaluma Creek, County of Marin, State of California, described as:

A strip of land one hundred feet in width lying fifty feet on each side of the following-described center line:

COMMENCING at Station 29 of the ordinary high water mark of the right bank of Petaluma Creek as shown on that certain map entitled "Map of the Ordinary High Water Mark on the Right Bank of Petaluma Creek vicinity of Green Point, Marin County, California." Said map being recorded July 25, 1960 in Case "E", Serial No. 1916S Official Records of Marin County; thence from said point of commencement along said ordinary high water mark, North $11^{\circ} 39' 33''$ West 170 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, said true point of beginning having coordinates $X = 1,420,256.60$ and $Y = 597,355.71$; thence from said TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, and leaving said ordinary high water mark North $61^{\circ} 42' 15''$ East 1150 feet to a point in Petaluma Creek, and the end of the herein described center line: Containing an area of 2.64 acres more or less.

Bearings, distances and coordinates are based on the California Coordinate System, Zone III.
