29. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, P.R.C. 3033.1, ORANGE COUNTY; UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W.O. 6854.

After consideration of Calendar Item 21 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE GRANTING TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3033.1 THROUGH JUNE 24, 1968, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS

P.R.C. 3033.1
LESSEE: Union Oil Company of California
COUNTY: Orange
AREA: Approximately 2,113 acres
ISSUED: July 25, 1963
WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE: Constructed platform Eva, drilled 32 wells. Four of the wells were redrilled. Thirty wells currently producing.
PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS: From July 12, 1966, through January 24, 1968
THIS DEFERMENT: From January 25, 1968, through June 24, 1968
REASON FOR REQUEST: To continue a reservoir study and to conduct a seismic survey early in 1968

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE GRANTING TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3033.1 THROUGH JUNE 24, 1968, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
