9. LEASE, STEAMBOAT SLOUGH, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; ROBERT M. EDWARDS - W.O. N-0026, P.R.C. 3885.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 1 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO ROBERT M. EDWARDS OF A 10-YEAR LEASE FROM JANUARY 1, 1968, IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENTAL OF \$150, PROVISION OF A SURETY BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5000 AND PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$200,000/\$600,000 FOR PERSONAL INJURY AND \$50,000 PROPERTY DAMAGE; FOR CONSTRUCTION OF AN ACCOMMODATION DOCK AND FUEL STATION ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, WITH LESSEE'S RIGHT TO RENEW FOR THREE ADDITIONAL PERIODS OF TEN YEARS EACH UPON SUCH REASONABLE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE STATE MIGHT IMPOSE; PROVIDED, THAT THE STATE SHALL RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REVIEW AND RESET THE RENTAL AT THE END OF THE FIRST FIVE-YEAR PERIOD.

FURTHER, THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE APPROVAL OF AN ACCEPTABLE ASSIGNMENT OF THE LEASE TO INTERNATIONAL HOUSEBOATS & RECREATION, INC.

LEASE

APPLICANT: Robert M. Edwards

LOCATION: A 0.308-acre parcel of tide and submerged land in Steamboat Slough, Sacramento County

PROPOSED USE: An accommodation dock and marine service station to serve the upland facility known as Steamboaters Club

TERMS: Initial period: 10 years, from January 1, 1968
Renewal options: 3 additional periods of 10 years each
Surety bond: \$5000
Public liability insurance: \$200,000/\$600,000
Property damage: \$50,000

CONSIDERATION: \$150 per annum

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
\$150 minimum rental for this type of lease or permit

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:
The U.S.A. Corps of Engineers has stated that an Army Permit will be issued.

Applicant is owner of upland.

EXHIBIT "A"

A parcel of tide and submerged land in Steamboat Slough adjacent to Grand Island, Sacramento County, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the ordinary high water mark of Steamboat Slough from which the Southwest corner of Section 8, Township 5 North, Range 4 East, M.D.B. & M., bears South 7° 35' 02" East 3,916.63 feet; thence from said point of beginning along said ordinary high water mark the following four courses:

- (1) South 52° 26' West 49.03 feet
- (2) South 39° 40' 30" West 175.18 feet
- (3) South 26° 36' West 115.79 feet
- (4) South 18° 11' West 60.00 feet, thence leaving said

ordinary high water mark North 42° 26' West 35.00 feet to a point in Steamboat Slough; thence parallel to said ordinary high water mark the following four courses:

- (5) North 18° 11' East 60.00 feet
- (6) North 26° 36' East 115.79 feet
- (7) North 39° 40' 30" East 175.18 feet
- (8) North 52° 26' East 49.03 feet; thence South 42° 26'

East 35.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING containing 0.308 acre.
